Nov Monday the 6th 1854

Commences with light breezes from the N. W. Steering E. by S. the Monhawk in Sight Middle and part light airs and calms from the N. W. Steering E. by S. Latter part fine breezes from the East Steering by the wind to the Southward saw 2 Sails and so ends these 24 hours Lat at Noon 34.54 S Long Old Rec 47.48 E New Rec 47.17 E

Tuesday the 7th

Commences with fine breezes from the E. Steering by the wind to the Southward saw 1 Sail Middle and latter part fine breezes from the E. Steering

by the wind to the Southward and Eastward Sail in Sight to the Seaward crew implored.

in breaking out Water meat and Small Stores. and so ends these 24 hours Lat 37.52 S

Wednesday the 8th Nov R 05.52 E

Commences with fine breezes from the E. Steering by the wind to the Southward and Eastward saw a Sail to the Seaward Middle and latter part light airs and calms from the Eastward heading to the Southward and Eastward at 6 A.M. saw the Monhawk lower her boats and pull to the Seaward Steered off for her at 8 A.M. the Monhawk's boats came on board again luffed to the wind again

and so ends these 24 hours Lat at noon 33.03 S

Thursday the 9th Nov R 06.48 W

Commences with calm and cloudy weather Saw two sails crew implored in setting up the fly jib rigging Middle and latter calm and light airs from the South Steering E. by S. and so ends these 24 hours

Friday Nov the 10th 1854

Commences with light breezes from the South Steering E. by S. at 1/2 past 2 P.M. saw and lowered the boats for Hump Backs but without success saw two Sails Middle and latter part light airs and calms from the South saw two Sails Lat 37.42 S and so ends these 24 hours Old Rec Long 07.02 W New 07.28 W

Saturday the 11th

Commences with calm weather heading to the Eastward saw two Sails Middle and latter part calm saw three Sails. caught a Porpoise Lat 37.31 S and so ends these 24 hours

Sunday the 12th

Commences with calm weather. Saw three Sails at 1/2 past 2 P.M. saw and lowered the Boats for a right whale but without success. Middle part calm. Latter part light breezes from the North Steering S. E. by E. saw fin Backs. four Sails in Sight and so ends these 24 hours Lat 37.42 S Long at 1/2 past 4 09.04 E

Monday the 13th

Commences with light breezes from the North Steering S. E. by E. saw two Sails Middle and latter part strong breezes from the S. W. Steering S. E. by E. saw 4 Sails. and so ends these 24 hours Lat 37.36 S Long 11.46 E

Tuesday the 14th

Commences with fine breezes from the S. W. Steering S. E. saw four Sails Middle part light breezes from the S. W. Steering S. E. latter part much the same Steering S. E. by E. saw 4 Sails Lat 37.45 S and so ends these 24 hours Long 13.02 W

Wednesday the 15th

Commences with breezes from the S. W. to S. W. Steering S. E. Middle and latter part light variable winds and calms Steering to the S. E. saw fin Backs. five Sails in Sight Lat at Noon 38.08 S and so ends these 24 hours Long at 4 13.37 W
