

Remarks On Board Ship Stephania

Sunday January the 7th 1855

Commences with fine breezes from the North Steering S. E. crew imploried in setting up Hooks and boiling Middle and latter part fresh gales from North and rainey finished boiling the whale and stowed the oil Between decks. and so ends these 24 hours No Ch

Monday the 8th

Commences with moderate gales from the North and rainey crew imploried in clearing up Decks laying to under a close reefed maintop sail heading to the westward at 6 P.M. wore Ship and headed to the Eastward. Middle part rainey

Latter fresh gales from the North laying to the wind heading to the Eastward crew imploried in scraping bone and so ends these 24 hours Lat 40. 10 S Long 86. 39 E

Tuesday the 9th

Commences with Strong breezes from the North laying to under close reefed maintop sail and fore sail crew imploried in cleaning bone at 4 P.M. wore Ship and stood to the Westward Middle and latter part much the same at 7 A.M. broke out and commenced stowing down the oil and so ends these 24 hours Lat 40. 57 S Long

Wednesday the 10th

Commences with Strong breezes from the West Steering South crew imploried in stowing down oil Middle and latter part Strong breezes from the S. W. and cloudy Steering Southward at 9 A.M. wore Ship and stood by the wind and Steered North crew imploried in scraping bone Lat 41. 30 S and so ends these 24 hours Long 87. 36 E

Cruising for right Whales

Thursday 11th

Commences with Strong breezes from the South Steering North crew imploried in scraping bone at 7 P.M. took in Sail and luffed to the wind heading to the westward at 8 A.M. made sail and Steered S. E. crew imploried in breaking out between decks and stowing away Bread and Flour. and so ends these 24 hours No Ch

Friday the 12th

Commences with fresh breezes from the S. W. Steering E. N. E. Saw Nothing at 3 P.M. took in Sail and Steered East Middle and latter part calm and light verable winds and cloudy weather saw grampuses crew imploried in Sundry jobs and so ends these 24 hours

Lat 39. 36 S Long 88. 11 E

Saturday the 13th

Commences with light airs from the N. E. Steering S. E. crew imploried in Sundry jobs Middle part light airs from the North Steering East. under short sail Latter part light airs from the N. W. and West Steering E. by S. crew imploried in washing and drying bone and so ends these 24 hours Lat 39. 41 S Long 89. 40 E

Sunday the 14th

Commences with light airs from the W. and S. W. Steering E. by S. Saw fin Backs Shot at 2 with balls crew imploried in washing and drying bone Middle part fresh breezes from the S. and Squally Steering E. S. E. Latter part fine breezes from the South Steering E. by S. and so ends these 24 hours Lat 39. 32 S Long 92. 14 W E

Monday the 15th

Commences with fine breezes from the S. Steering E. by N. Saw a fin Back Middle and latter part light airs from the West Steering E. by N. crew imploried in Sundry jobs and so ends these 24 hours Lat 38. 34 S Long 93. 58 E
