Commences with light airs from the South

South at 4 A.M. wore Ship and stood by the wind
to the Eastward under double reefed top Sails
at 12 past 7 A.M. saw Cape Leuven bearing E. by S
at 8 Steered North and so ends these 21 hours Lat 33° 55' S
Long 115° 21' E

Long 115° 16' E

working up to the anchorage at 2 A.M. came
