Friday April the 27. A 1855.

Commences with fresh gales from E. by S. laying by the wind heading S. by E. finished the main yard and sent it aloft saw nothing. Latter part fresh gale from the N. E. Steering N. W. and so ends these 24 hours

Saturday the 28

Commences with fresh breezes from the N. E. Steering N. N. W. at 4 P. M. Spoke the Pir of New Bedford Capt Derval 8 months out with 150 lb of oil. Latter part strong breezes from the E. N. E. Steered by the wind to the Northward. Saw one sail

and so ends these 24 hours

Sunday the 29th

Commences with fresh breezes from the E. N. E. Steering by the wind to the Northward saw two sails. Latter part strong breezes from the E. N. E. Saw Sulphur bottoms Steered by the wind on Diferant tacks saw 3 sails and so ends these 24 hours

Monday the 30th

Commences with fine breezes from the E. N. E. Steered on Diferant tack saw Sulphur bottoms 3 sails in sight at 1/2 past 5 P. M. Spoke the Bark Adventure of London Latter part fine breezes from the E. N. E. Steered by

the wind to the Northward saw two sails and so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday the 1st

Commences with light airs from the East heading by the wind to the Southward saw one sail. Latter part fine breezes from the N. N. E. Steered to the Southward and Eastward. Saw four sails and so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday May the 2nd 1855

Commences with fresh breezes from the N. N. E. Steered to the E. E. S. E. Saw 4 sails. Latter part fresh breezes from the North Steered S. W. by S. Saw one sail and so ends these 24 hours

Thursday the 3rd

Commences with with light breezes from the North at 2 P. M. heavy squalls with rain from the South took in sail at 4 P. M. set the fore and main topsails and jib. Latter part fresh breezes from the S. E. Steering by the wind to the S. W. Lat 25. 50 S and so ends these 24 hours

Friday the 4th

Commences with fresh breezes from the S. E. Steering by the wind to the S. S. W. Latter part fine breezes from the S. E. Steering N. W. by N. saw fin backs and so ends these 24 hours

Lat 25. 08 S

Long 109. 40 E

Saturday the 5th

Commences with fine breezes from the S. E. Steering N. W. saw Porpoises. Latter part light breezes from the S. E. Steering N. W. Saw killars and fin backs and so ends these 24 hours

Sunday the 6th

Commences with light breezes from the S. E. Steering by N. W. and N. N. W. Latter part light airs from the E. N. E. Steering by the wind to the North saw one sail. and so ends.

Monday the 7th

Commences with light airs and from the N. E. and calms at 6 P. Spoke the Bark Mapasvit of Matigosa. Latter part light breezes from the East Steering N. S. W. Saw two sails and so ends these 24 hours
