

Remarks On Board Ship Stephania

Sunday July the 6th 1856.

Commences with fine breezes from the south steering N. N. E. Middle and Latter part the same. at 8 A. M. steered N. by E. and so ends these 24 hours. Lat 26. 44 S

Monday the 7th

Commences with fresh breezes from the S. E. at 1 P. M. saw a sperm whale giving the boats in pursuit and chased till dark without success at sun set saw a large body of whales to the leeward took in sail to Double reefed top sails and stood on the Eastern tack Middle part fine at 2 A. M. wore ship and stood by the wind to the S. W. Latter part much the same

steering on Viferant coarces saw fin Backs Lat 26. 14 S and so ends these 24 hours Long 118. 18 E

Tuesday the 8th

Commences with light breezes from the S. E. steering to the North Middle and Latter part the same took in the top gallant sails. and mainsail and clued down the top sails at day light made all sail. implord turning in the Larboard main riggin and so ends these 24 hours Lat 24. 31 S Long 107. 54 E

Wednesday the 9th

Commences with fine breezes from the S. E. steering North implord in fitting riggin Middle and Latter part the same steered N. E. through the night under short sail at day light made all sail and steered N. by W. at 9 A. M. spoke the Bark Pacific for New Bedford Capt Sherman 11 months out with 350 barrels of oil Lat 23. 24 S and so ends these 24 hours Long

Thursday the 10th

Commences with fine breezes from the S. E. steering N. by W. implord in fitting riggin Middle part the same took in sail and luffed to on the Eastern tack with the main yard aback Latter part the same at day light made sail and steered N. N. W. and so ends these 24 hours Lat 22. 24 S Long 106. 30 E

Bound North

July Friday the 11th 1856

Commences with fine breezes from the S. E. steering N. N. W. Middle part the same Latter part fine breezes from the S. E. steering N. W. by N. implord in fitting the main riggin and so ends. Lat 20. 39 S Long 107. 51 E

Saturday the 12th

Commences with fresh breezes from the S. E. steering North Middle part the same Latter part strong breezes from the S. E. steering N. by E. implord in fitting riggin and so ends these 24 hours Lat 18. 46 S Long 108. 00 E

Sunday the 13th

Commences with strong breezes from the S. E. steering N. by E. Middle and Latter part the same Latter part steered North and so ends these 24 hours Lat 16. 39 S Long 108. 00 E

Monday the 14th

Commences with fresh breezes from the S. E. steering North. Middle part rainey. Latter part fine wind S. E. steering North implord in fitting and turning in the mizen riggin and so ends these 24 hours Lat 14. 12 S Long 108. 04 E

Tuesday the 15th

Commences with fresh breezes from the S. E. with some rain implord in fitting riggin Middle and Latter part fine breezes from the S. E. steering by the wind to the Northward. implord in fitting rigging and so ends. Lat 12. 13 S Long 107. 50 E

Wednesday the 16th

Commences with fine breezes from the N. E. by E. steering by the wind to the N. by W. Middle and Latter part light airs from the S. E. steering by the wind to the North and so ends these 24 hours Lat 10. 39 S Long 107. 36 E

Thursday the 17th

Commences with light airs from the East steering N. by W. N. W. implord in fitting riggin Middle and Latter part fine breezes from the S. E. steering N. N. W. Lat 8. 58 S Long 107. 00 E

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
