day discharging the ballast.

Remarks Thursday October 9th

All this day fine weather the wind
from the S.W. called all hands
at 5 A.M. & turned to, at 5 P.M.
finished discharging the ballast
& hauled the ship to a wharf to
take in coal all the rest of
the day employed in clearing
the hold.

Remarks Friday October 10th

All this day fine weather
called all hands at 5 A.M.
& moved the ship over to the
fore peak and took the
remainder of the ballast on deck
moved the ship to an other sheet
for deeper water & came up
with the main & mast back
stays and after shroud.

Remarks Saturday October 11th

The first part of these 24 hours
raining called all hands at 5 A.M.
all this day employed in tending
to the loading the vessel and
coming up with the fore and
main rigging & topmast Back stays
finished loading at 5 P.M.

Remarks Sunday October 12th

All this day good weather put on
called all hands at 5 A.M. and
secured the decks the rest of the
day the sabbath is strictly observed.
