Remarks Wednesday October 15th

 called all hands at 6 o'clock & worked

 washing ship took the Starboard
 anchor on the bow

 All this day the wind from the
 N. East, with cloudy weather
 but no rain 2 1/2 vessel lying here
 wind bound called all hands
 at 5 o'clock and worked all
 day fishing the N.Y.G. yard
 a new

 Called all hands at 2 1/2 o'clock A.M.
 & gave short made sale with the
 Pilot on board at 5 A.M. took
 the anchor at 8 A.M. dropped it
 off Pictou light & clewed up the
 sail the rest of the day all
 hands employed in ships duty
