Commenced with strong winds from the
S.E. with snow middle and latter parts
of heavy storm from the S.E. with much
snow could not work at 11 A.M. the
wind shifted to the N.E. and blew heavy
to Ends

Remarks on Board Sunday December 7th
Commenced with a heavy gale from the
N.E. with much snow middle part
the wind W.N.W. and stormy
latter part the same to Ends

Remarks on Board Monday December 8th
Commenced with strong winds from N.W.
with clear weather
middle part the same
latter part light winds from
W.W. with clear cold weather
employed in tacking in cargo
to Ends

Remarks on Board Tuesday December 9th
Commenced with light winds from N.W.
with clear cold weather employed in
tacking in cargo lots of drift ice in the
River middle and latter parts present
weather tacking on the deck to the Ends

Remarks on Board Wednesday December 10th
Commenced with light air from North with
present weather employed in tacking on
the deck to the
middle and latter parts present weather
finished tacking in cargo to Ends

Remarks on Board Thursday December 11th
Commenced with light winds from
N.W. with present weather employed
in clearing up tops the foremast anchor
and took on board 10 spare gills
Boom middle part light air from
S.W. with present weather latter part
light and baffling wind and to 10
at 10 A.M. took the anchor and got
under way and worked down the
river to Ends
