all this day Light winds and thick
weather employed in getting ready for
sea, So Ends

Barth Chandler price on her Passage from Scotland to East Port in 1863

16 Feb 6 W F Thursday February 19th 1863
commenced with calm and foggy
weather Laying in ardoon in waiting for
a chance to get out middle part
the same
Latter part Light winds from S E
with foggy weather at 9 AM we moved
and got under way and went to
sea Steaming S W by S employed in
stowing the anchors So Ends

16 Feb 6 W F Remarks on Board Friday February 20th
commenced with Light winds and
foggy weather ship under all
sail employed in stowing and lashing
things for sea middle part pleasant
Latter part Strong winds from S W
force S W by W ship under all
sails So Ends
Lat 55.44 N by obs

16 Feb 6 W F Remarks on Board Saturday February 21st
commenced with Strong winds and thick
weather ship under all sail at 3 PM
took in F. J. Sails and got F. J. Sail
at 4 PM double reefed the F. J. Sails
at 6 PM reefed the bows and took in
the G. J. and Sprung middle part Strong
winds and thick weather winds S W at 8 AM
the wind hauled to the N W and moderated
at 6 AM reared ship to the N W by N and
set the bows and G. J. and Sprung
Latter part the same So Ends
Lat 55.44 N by obs Long 11.34 W by obs
