these twenty four hours, Wind E.S.E.

Thursday April 30th /63

Wind East, weather clear. Painting
Ship outside -

Friday May 1st /63

Clear fine weather through this
day. Cleaning and painting ship -

Saturday May 2nd /63

First part of these twenty four hours
fine and clear weather. Wind East
Painting ship outside

Sunday May 3rd /63

Light winds from South-East
Weather clear and pleasant

Monday May 4th /63

Light South East winds with rain
through this day.

Tuesday May 5th /63

Strong winds from the North
with clear cold weather through
out these twenty four hours -

Wednesday May 6th /63

Comes with light winds from the
East. Weather clear and fine
Last part much the same -
Painting Ship and discharging
Ballast -

Thursday May 7th /63

Wind S.S.E with drizzling rain
throughout these twenty four
hours. Discharged all Ballast with
the exception of about twenty-five
tons. Got Hold ready for cargo.

Friday May 8th 1863

Commenced fine and pleasant
Digger in Sib. Boom, and took it
on deck. At 5 PM got a Raft of
Deals alongside. Finished painting
Ship outside.

Saturday May 9th /63

Clear fine weather throughout
this day. Wind East, and light.
Stewards to work taking in
cargo. Loosed sails to dry, and
jibbed them again

Sunday May 10th /63

Fine clear pleasant weather through
these twenty four hours. Wind East and
very light.

Monday May 11th /63

First part wind East. Weather clear
Later part Wind N.E. and rainy
Drs. rafts from the shore -

Tuesday May 12th /63

Wind South West and very light
Weather fine and pleasant
Taking in cargo -

Wednesday May 13th /63

Light winds from South East with
rain, during these twenty four hours
At 11 AM got a raft of Deals alongside

Thursday May 14th /63

Wind South East and light. Weather cool
and cloudy. At 12 Noon got two small
rafts of Lumber alongside. Stewards
employed taking them in. Got a new
Sib. Boom alongside and took it on board
