Wednesday May 22d

Light breeze at 8 AM with squalls
 of wind & rain at 6 PM more ship & boat in light sail
 and halloed up the courses kept to Middle part
 calm & pleasant. Water part light southeasterly
 breeze steering up to 4 PM by the compasses &
 porpoises in sight Lat 48° 39' N
 Long 120° 08' W

Thursday May 23d
 Light baffling southeasterly breeze
 fine weather steering N.W. at 7 PM hauled
 to wind on fore tack by 4 PM Middle part
 light easterly breeze hauled to N.W. & Water
 part much the same saw porpoises & grampoids

Friday May 24th
 Light easterly breeze fine weather
 heading N.W. on one tack N.W. & on the
 other Middle part wind veered to N.W. &
 hauled by 4 PM Water part light air
 at 4 PM steering N.W. grampoids & porpoises
 in sight Lat 48° 36' N
 Long 120° 11' W

Saturday May 25th
 Light air at 8 AM fine weather
 steering up at 4 PM hauled to by 4 PM
 Middle part light southerly air by 4 PM
 water to N.W. Water part much the same hauled
 to N.W. porpoises & grampoids in sight

Sunday May 26th
 Light southerly air pleasant weather
 hauled by 4 PM veered southerly to N.W. steering up
 Middle part light easterly breeze Water part
 light southeasterly air heading from N.W. to N
 saw grampoids Lat 48° 28' N
 Long 119° 46' W

Fisher Master cruising in the Arctic Sea
Thursday May 27th

Light southeasterly air baffling on
 southern tack at 8 PM veered southerly to N.W. &
 steering up by 4 PM Middle part light air at 4 PM
 Water part light baffling air with squalls of
 rain started down 23 fms of air Lat 48° 40' N
 Long 120° 12' W

Friday May 28th
 Light breeze at 4 PM steering N.W. & B
 at 6 PM veered to N.W. steering N.W. Middle part
 calm Water part light baffling northeasterly
 breeze & duff on the southern tack Lat 48° 38' N
 Long 120° 37' W

Saturday May 29th
 Light baffling northeasterly air
 heading to N.W. at 7 PM steering N.W. Middle
 part calm Water part light baffling air with
 squalls of rain Lat 48° 35' N
 Long 121° 10' W

Sunday May 30th
 Moderate breeze at 4 PM for the
 last 4 hours something unusual to this part
 of the world by 4 PM at 7 PM squalls hauled
 light sails Middle part light air at 4 PM by 4 PM
 Water part much the same the base of clouds
 in sight Lat 48° 32' N
 Long 121° 27' W

Monday May 31st
 Light baffling air from N.W. to N
 steering N.W. Middle part equally steering N.W.
 Water part light air at 4 PM steering N.W. at 6
 PM raised school of seals off our bow about 25 miles
 from Cape Wankarem Cape Wankarem at 8 AM
 lowered the boats at 10 AM the L. arched boat fastened the
 ropes to leeward and the boat after them took the whale
 along side about 12 AM
