

## Remarks on board Bk. Humbear. C. Fisher

Monday June 28th

Light baffling air at 2 Pm had the whales all secure got dinner & commenced cutting at 5 Pm & whales in boiling at 7 Pm squalls off shore and rain Middle part light air and calms employed boiling Latter part finished cutting the other three whales saw them whales from deck did not lower having as much as we could handle at present. Day & Merchantmen working to westward still boiling

Tuesday June 29th

Light west breeze hup Pm & under double reefs at 2 Pm saw them whales. Dyer got the two quarter boats with stench the starboard part her whale & 50 fms the starboard got her whale to the ship about 6 Pm. Employed boiling at daylight cut in the whale set double reefs topsail steering Pm with light southeasterly breeze still boiling

Wednesday June 30th

Light breeze at Pm hup Pm & boiling. Middle & Latter part light westerly breeze at 10 am finished Land about 30 miles off

Thursday July 1st

Heavy westerly squalls at 2 Pm fished foretopsail foresail in masts thick and raining Middle part more moderate set foretopsail Latter part light breeze at Pm hup Pm employed storing oil in the ground

Friday July 2d

Fresh breeze at Pm hup Pm fished fore and spanker at 6 Pm more moderate set like the sail. fore & spanker stowed 123 bbls of oil. Middle part moderate southeasterly breeze hup Pm & at 8 Pm more to Pm. Latter part much the same at 8 am more to Pm. Lat

## Master of the coast of Celebes. Pookoo. Sea

Saturday July 3d

Light breeze S to S by E and fine weather steering Pm Middle part steering N Latter part light breeze and calms stopped down at 7 Pm for some of the last catching making in all 150 bbls or there abouts

Sunday July 4th

Light baffling northwesterly breeze fine weather heading Pm Middle part steering N Latter part light breeze at Pm saw grampoids and Blackfish

Monday July 5th

Light baffling northwesterly breeze heading Pm Middle part light and calms Latter part much the same

Lat 1.42 N  
Long 121.57 E

Tuesday July 6th

Light northerly breeze steering N at 8 Pm light breeze at Pm Middle part light northwesterly breeze with some thunder and lightning Latter part light southerly breeze

Lat 1.40 N  
Long 121.46 E

Wednesday July 7th

Light northerly breeze and calms heading Pm westward making little progress strong head current Middle part when in same Latter part calm going stern for most great quantities of drift wood in sight
