

Remarks on board Rk Chunbeam & Fisher

Wednesday Sept 22d  
Light westerly breeze with squalls of fair weather. At 8 AM changed light sails luffed to Port & dark threatening weather with thunder and lightning. Middle part light southwesterly breeze. At 4 PM luffed to Port. Latter part which the same luffed to Port. Raining ship

Thursday Sept 23d  
Light southwesterly breeze with squalls of rain. At 4 PM luffed to Port. Middle part light southwesterly breeze but it luffed to Port. Latter part which the same

Friday Sept 24th  
Moderate southerly breeze with squalls of rain. At 4 PM luffed to Port. Working up to Port. Strong northerly current. Middle part squalls. At 7 PM set the mainsail. Latter part moderate breeze luffing to Port & Port. Repairing chainsail. Bat 2.54 PM. Long 130.17

Saturday Sept 25th  
Moderate southerly breeze heading from Port & Port. Enriched. Mainmast and bent. Middle part light southwesterly breeze but Port & Port. Latter part which the same. Bat 2.12 PM. Long 131.07

Sunday Sept 26th  
Light southwesterly breeze fine weather. At 4 PM luffed to Port. Middle part squalls the same. Latter part light luffing and calm. Bat 1.48 PM. Long 130.55

Master cruising off Moritz

Monday Sept 27th  
Light air and calm pleasant weather heading southeasterly. Middle part light northwesterly steering Port. Latter part light air at Port steering Port. Employed breaking out and coffering oil. Bat 1.38 PM. Long 130.25

Tuesday Sept 28th  
Light northeasterly breeze fine weather steering Port. At 4 PM luffed on Port. Middle part much the same steering Port & Port. Latter part strong luffing breeze under double reef working up oil. Bat 1.28 PM. Long 130.13

Wednesday Sept 29th  
Light luffing breeze fine weather steering Port & Port. At 4 PM finished on the starboard side. All sail on the ship kept southwesterly breeze. Middle part fresh breeze. Doubled reefed the topsails. Latter part much the same. Several of the Board Peter in sight kept the ship Port. Commenced breaking out on Port side. Bat 0.55 PM. Long 131.04

Thursday Sept 30th  
Fresh southwesterly breeze luffed to Port. At 4 PM luffed in foretopsail & foresail. At 6 PM finished in mainbatchesway got supper & set foretopsail. Middle part much the same now to Port. Latter part moderate breeze made some sail kept ship Port & Port to clear the land at 12 AM raised the Jena. Bat 0.44 PM. Long 131.20. For them.
