

Remarks on board Bk Plunbeam C.

Monday Oct 25th

Began with light westerly breeze and pleasant breeze. Middle part much the same. Latter part light southerly breeze with rain steering in for land. Employed beaking out shoals for oil.

Tuesday Oct 26th

Light southerly breeze fine weather steering N. by E. Middle part light breeze and calm. Latter part light southerly breeze steering different courses from N. by E. to N. by N. Blackfish in sight.

Wednesday Oct 27th

Began with light southerly breeze and pleasant weather steering N. by E. at 6 PM hauled up. The courses sailed to N. by E. Middle part much the same. Latter part lashed to N. by E.

Thursday Oct 28th

Began with light southerly breeze fine weather. At 6 PM lashed to N. by E. Middle part light southerly breeze. At 1 PM lashed to N. by E. Latter part southerly breeze lashed to N. by E.

Friday Oct 29th

Began with light southerly breeze steering N. by E. at 6 PM hauled up. The courses & some of the light sails hauled up. Middle part the same steering N. by E. Latter part light southerly breeze steering N. by E. Blackfish in sight. Coopering oil.

Fisher Master. Cruising in Moducca passage

Saturday Oct 30th

Moderate southerly breeze steering N. by E. at 6 PM had a squall with some rain. Hauled light sails. Middle part much the same. At daylight commenced beaking out to start oil at 8 AM lashed to N. by E. Great many Phylloporhynchus in sight.

Sunday Oct 31st

Light westerly breeze and fine weather heading northward at 6 PM finished steaming down 30 lbs of oil lashed to N. by E. and washed ship. Middle part light westerly breeze steering N. by E. Latter part southerly breeze heading southerly. Phylloporhynchus in sight.

Monday Nov 1st

Light southerly breeze fine weather steering N. by E. at 6 PM lashed to N. by E. Middle part much the same steering N. by E. Latter part light N. by E.

Tuesday Nov 2nd

Light northwesterly breeze and fine weather heading N. by E. at 6 PM lashed to N. by E. Middle part light southerly breeze. At 6 PM lashed to N. by E. Latter part steering N. by E.

Wednesday Nov 3rd

Light southerly breeze steering N. by E. at 6 PM lashed to N. by E. Middle part much the same. Latter part moderate southerly breeze heading to N. by E. at 8 PM passed a school of sperm whales off the bow about 8 miles off. Then after toward the boats. At 12 am the mast was fastened to the starboard and bow boat.
