

Remarks on board Bk Chuburn & Fisher

Wednesday Nov 24th

Light variable breezes heading
northwest by N. Middle part calm. Batter
part light northwesterly breezes heading
northwesterly

Lat 10.19 N
Long 125.31 W

Thursday Nov 25th

Commenced with calm &
clear weather. Middle part light northwesterly
breezes by E. by S. & by S. Batter part
much the same

Lat 0.25 N
Long 125.24 W

Friday Nov 26th

Light northerly breezes and fine
weather by E. by S. & by S. Middle
part steering by S. Batter part
steering different courses from S. by E.

Saturday Nov 27th

Began with light northwesterly
breezes and fine weather steering by E.
About 2 PM shifted to by E. by S.
at 4 PM, lashed to S. by E. Middle
part light northerly breezes lashed to S. by E.
Batter part much the same lashed
trying to work northward making
little progress on account of a head
current

Sunday Nov 28th

Moderate northwesterly breezes
and squally heading from N. by E. by S.
at 4 PM, lashed into land lashed off
shore by N. Middle part light
northerly breezes by E. by S. Batter
part southwesterly breezes steering
by E. by S.

Master Cruising in Red Sea passage off N. S. G.

Monday Nov 29th

Moderate westerly breezes and
battering by E. by S. Middle part
much the same heading southwesterly
Batter part southwesterly breezes and
squally with some rain heading heading
northwesterly. About 8 AM lashed for
Blackfish. One of the barboas got
one.

Tuesday Nov 30th

Began with moderate southwesterly
and overcast by E. at 4 PM went to S. by E.
Middle part much the same. Batter part
steering breezes and squally under doubloons
batted out the Blackfish.

Wednesday Dec 1st

Began with moderate southerly breezes
heading southwesterly. Middle part much
the same. Batter part calm. Blackfish
and Pinbacks in sight.

Thursday Dec 2d

Still continues calm. Middle part
light northerly breezes steering by E. by S. Batter
part much the same at 11 AM steering to
Pinbacks. Blackfish and porpoises in sight.

Friday Dec 3d

Began with moderate northwesterly
breezes and pleasant by E. by S. at 4 PM
strong breezes doubled the topsail at
1 PM. Second sudant to S. by E. look in pit
& mainsail. lashed by E. by S. Fresh
breezes Middle part moderate by
S. by E. Batter part light breezes
and fine weather all sail out. Crooked
point of S. by E. heading about 10 PM
Backed off shore Pinbacks in sight.
