

Remarks on board Bk Dunbar C. Fisher

Monday Jan 3rd Began with light baffling air and calm head of wind. Middle & latter part much the same

Tuesday Jan 4th Began with light baffling air and calm. Middle & latter part light westerly breeze heading northwesterly. A sail in sight to windward steering southward

Wednesday Jan 5th Began with light squally breeze clear weather steering by the lead about 4 mile S. Outer part light breeze heading northwesterly. Middle part moderate northwesterly breeze heading by S. Latter part light air and baffling

Thursday Jan 6th Began with light air and baffling. Pleasant weather heading northward. Middle part moderate northwesterly breeze by S. Latter part light and baffling air. A sail in sight heading northwesterly

Friday Jan 7th Began with light northwesterly breeze by S. Middle & latter part variable winds and squalls with rain. At 8 am raised a school of sperm whales going to windward. At 8 am lowered the boats and gave chase. Ob ends this day chasing whales

Master. Working up to North

Saturday Jan 8th Began with light and variable breezes with squalls at 2 PM all boats on board. Master's boat got a good whale got dinner and at 3 PM began to hunt quite success. At 4 PM whale in heading off shore. Generally rainy weather. Middle and latter part much the same heading northwesterly. About 10 am started the work.

Sunday Jan 9th Began with fresh northwesterly breeze quite success with a 1/2 m. success. At 2 PM raised sperm whales beginning lowered three boats. At boat fastened but the day very soon after. At 4 PM all boats on board. Middle part very heavy squalls of rain still boiling. Latter part light breezes and pleasant. Made all sail. At 8 am raised sperm whale lowered three boats. Lights breezes with a heavy swell. Ob ends chasing and boiling whales

Monday Jan 10th Began with light breezes at 10 AM ship heaving for boats. At 4 PM all boats on board. At boat brought a whale. Shortened sail and stood off shore still boiling. Middle & latter part fresh breezes and success. At daylight finished boiling and began to hunt. At 8 am whale in heading off shore. With pleasant weather at 10 am started the work.

Tuesday Jan 11th Began with fresh breezes at 10 AM heading in shore employed boiling. At 4 PM thick weather with some rain. Middle & latter part much the same. At daylight finished boiling. Fresh breezes and success
