

Remarks on board Rk Phunbeam C. Fisher

Wednesday Jan 19th

Begins with fresh northwesterly breeze and rain. Heading southwesterly. About 8 PM more moderate westerly breeze and some of the light sails. Steers in right bearing. In the forenoon a light breeze. Middle part moderate breeze and clear weather. Latter part overcast at daylight commenced cooping oil.

Thursday Jan 20th

Begins with moderate breeze and hazy with light rain still cooping. About 12 PM cooping on account of rain. Middle part light airs and calms. Latter part light northwesterly breeze with some rain steering to the N. Finished cooping and stowed 16 pipes of oil in Main hatch lower hold. Weather in sight. Lat 2.40 N

Friday Jan 21st

Begins with light northwesterly breeze and rain steering to the N. for land. At 11 PM luffed to wind. Light breeze. Under double reef. Middle part much the same. Latter part light northwesterly breeze and overcast heading eastward. At day light called all hands and commenced making out to stow oil in a forehold. Weather in sight off the bow.

Saturday Jan 22nd

Begins with light northwesterly breeze & overcast heading northwesterly. Steaming down. Weather to windward employed in same way. About 5 PM finished stowing down oil taken Jan 19th & 20th. Capt. White came on board. Had just finished stowing down oil taken Jan 15th. Middle part light breeze and fine weather. Latter part light airs & calms. Steaming previous between decks. Weather in sight.

Sunday Jan 23rd

Begins with light airs and calms heading northward. Breaking out shoals. About 8 PM finished triced ship and shortened sail. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze steering different courses from 20 to 30.

Monday Jan 24th

Begins with light southwesterly breeze and fine weather steering northwesterly. At 11 PM shortened sail and luffed to wind. Light breeze. Weather in sight. Middle part light airs and calms. Latter part the same.

Tuesday Jan 25th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze and pleasant steering. At 11 PM weather threatening with some thunder and lightning. Under double reef. Middle part rain heading southwesterly. At 1 PM were 1/2 N. Latter part pleasant steering. Weather in sight. At 11 AM discovered her shading. Kept ship for her. She ends this day.

Wednesday Jan 26th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze and fine weather steering northwesterly for ship. About 1 PM saw her take a whale along side. Boat ahead chasing. About 3 PM kept ship. Weather in sight. Middle part light breeze. Latter part light breeze steering different courses from 20 to 30.
