

Remarks on board Bk. Chinkam B. Fisher

Thursday Jan 27th

Begins with moderate northeasterly breezes and fine weather steering for Igloos at 11 AM boat got to ship with milk. The other boats to leeward with whales at 4 PM all boats embayed and whales made fast. Got dinner and at 4.30 PM began to cut. The Walther in sight whaling. At 6.30 PM two whales in dark Walther still in sight but was unable to tell if she had taken any. Middle part employed chasing away heads. Latter part light northeasterly breezes at daylight called all hands and began to cut at 1 PM. Sun and cutting and were till 4 PM. Rain started the work.

Friday Jan 28th

Begins with moderate breezes at 11 AM with fine weather but at 1 PM sunset shortened sail and went to the middle part much the same. Latter part northeasterly breezes heading northeasterly.

Saturday Jan 29th

Begins with fresh breezes at 11 AM. About 1 PM spoke the Walther. Capt. F. went on board. Thursday she chased whales all day without success. Had 75 lbs of oil on deck taken Tuesday. Heading to land at 11 AM. Middle part much the same. Latter part light airs and calms with some rain. Walther in sight.

Sunday Jan 30th

Begins with moderate southwesterly breezes and rain heading to the N. At sunset changed light legs and went to the middle part light breezes at daylight started at 11 AM in for the land. The Walther off at 11 AM working to the N. At 1.30 AM raised 10 PM whales going. I made signals for Walther and lowered 4 boats and gave chase. Light breezes at 4 PM. Ends chasing whales.

Monday Jan 31st

Begins with light northeasterly breezes and fine weather steering for Igloos at 11 PM. Boat got to ship with milk. Tuesday Feb 1st

Begins with light northeasterly breezes with some rain heading to the N. At 1 PM raised 10 PM whales off weather beam. At 2 PM lowered 10 PM. B. boats and Walther to windward. At 4.30 PM gave up the chase as the whales were out sight to windward. 6.30 PM boats on board. Shortened sails but kept on. Rain. Latter part light northeasterly breezes and fine weather but at 1 PM still cutting. Walther not in sight. Lat 5.4 PM Long 128.08 W

Wednesday Feb 2nd

Begins with fine northeasterly breezes steering southwesterly under double reef. At 11 PM Walther in sight. Middle part much the same. Latter part light southwesterly breezes with some rain. At 12 AM finished cutting. Walther in sight cutting.

Thursday Feb 3rd

Begins with light northeasterly breezes with some rain. Set the main sail and some of the light sails heading to the N. At 3.30 PM discovered the Walther heading. At dark steering to the N under short sail. Middle part went to the N. Rain. Fresh breezes. Latter part much the same steering southwesterly different course. Walther setting up junky work. Lat 5.08 N Long 128.45 W
