

Remarks on board Bk. Punbeam D. Fisher  
Friday Feb 11th

Began with fresh northeasterly breeze and squally rain. At 10 A.M. at dark shortened sail. Middle part hauled off. At 12.30 P.M. more to S. Batten part steering O.P. About 4 am finished talking. Lat 4.02 S Long 128.00 W

Saturday Feb 12th

Began with fresh northeasterly breeze and squally steering O.P. At 12.30 P.M. luffed to hup O.P. Middle part the same. Batten part steering O.P. Lat 3.44 S Long 128.10 W

Sunday Feb 13th

Began with moderate northeasterly breeze and squally steering O.P. At 4 P.M. fresh breeze with rain. Middle part the same. Batten part luffed to hup. Only and the 10.00 A.M. in sight.

Monday Feb 14th

Began with fresh northeasterly breeze and squally heading northwesterly. About 8 P.M. spoke the 10.00 A.M. Middle part much the same. Batten part moderate breeze. Saw a Frigate.

Tuesday Feb 15th

Began with moderate northeasterly breeze with light rain squally fresh O.P. At sundown shortened sail. Fresh breeze. Middle part much the same. Batten part steering O.P.

Wednesday Feb 16th

Began with moderate northeasterly breeze and fine weather steering O.P. At sundown shortened sail steering O.P. Middle part much the same. Batten part light breeze and fine weather steering O.P. At 11 P.M. raised a whale heading to O.P. At 11 am landed the whale. To land chasing.

Master Cruising off New York P.C.O.  
Thursday Feb 17th

Began with baffling breeze and squally steering for the whale which are still chasing. 10.00 A.M. in sight to windward ahead. At 6.30 P.M. all boats on board without success. Northeasterly breeze hup O.P. Under double reefs. Middle part the same at 11 P.M. more to S. At 8 P.M. more again. Batten part light breeze steering different courses from O.P. to O.P. Saw 4 jammers.

Friday Feb 18th

Began with light northerly breeze and rain. Under short sail heading northwesterly. Middle part the same. Batten part pleasant. At 6.30 A.M. more to S. At 11 A.M. luffed to hup. Lat 3.15 S

Saturday Feb 19th

Began with light northeasterly breeze and fine weather steering southwesterly. At 8 P.M. saw waterwater. Did not make it out. Middle part steering O.P. Batten part fresh breeze steering different courses from O.P. to O.P.

Sunday Feb 20th

Began with fresh northerly breeze and clear weather steering "hup" at 8.30 P.M. hauled into Fishers Island. Kept ship off O.P. At sundown shortened sail. Luffed to hup O.P. Middle part the same at 12 P.M. more to S. Batten part light breeze at 1 P.M. At daylight hauled into Fishers. Left way to S. At 8.30 P.M. raised a large O.P. whale heading to O.P. At 12.30 lowered the boat and gave chase as we did not gain on him. Whale about 4 miles off. To land chasing.
