

Remarks on board Bk. Conbeam S. Fisher
Monday Feb 21st

Began with light northwesterly breeze steering for the whale. About 4.30 pm the Bow Boat went alongside of the whale. But the boatmen missed it. At 6.30 pm all boats on board got supper look in the light sails for a D. Middle part the same at 8 pm. Reached to W. Batter part fresh breezes working to windward.

Tuesday Feb 22nd

Began with moderate northwesterly breeze and pleasant weather on western look. At sundown went to S. O. and double reefed. Dark threatening weather. Middle part squally. Batter part the same at daylight went to S. O.

Wednesday Feb 23rd

Began with fresh baffling breezes and squally working northward. Look and tack. Middle part strong breezes on western look. Batter part strong northwesterly with much rain. Squally at 1 pm. At 11 am wore ship. Walloon in sight off weather quarter.

Thursday Feb 24th

Began with strong northwesterly breezes and squally on the western look. At 5.30 pm spoke the Walloon she had taken 85 lbs of oil the last week. Middle & Batter part the same. At 7 am wore to W.

Friday Feb 25th

Began with fresh northwesterly breezes on western look. At 6 pm wore to W. O. Middle part the same. Batter part steering S. O. At 11 pm raised the Walloon off but low steering with one

Saturday Feb 26th

Began with fresh breezes and squally weather. At 6 pm spoke the Walloon. Duff B. went aboard. At 6 pm stuffed to by up a 1/2 of rain. Band in sight off the beam. Middle part mostly breezes steering. Batter part steering S. O. Weather moderating.

Sunday Feb 27th

Began with moderate squally breezes & pleasant weather steering S. O. O. Walloon off to leeward steering with breeze. About 3 pm passed the land off weather now baffled to S. O. Walloon sent at sunset. Middle part the same. Batter part steering southwesterly along the land.

Monday Feb 28th

Began with light baffling winds and calm pleasant weather heading southwesterly. At 6 pm light northwesterly breezes steering S. O. Middle part the same. Batter part moderating breezes at daylight wore to S. O. and began to break out the after hatch but did not stem out. At 11 am finished stowing down 80 lbs of oil taken Feb 24th.

Tuesday Mar 1st

Began with moderate northwesterly breezes & pleasant weather on western look. Employed stowing provision below. At 4 pm finished washed off the decks and got supper. At 6 pm wore to W. O. Steering weather with lightening under squalls. Middle part squally. Batter part baffling breezes with squalls of rain.

Wednesday Mar 2nd

Began with baffling breezes and much rain working northward. Look and tack. At sundown banded light sails northwesterly breezes. At 6 pm Middle part the same at 2 pm looked to W. Batter part fine weather at 8 am looked west.
