

Remarks on board Bk Sunbeam C. Fisher
 Thursday Mar 24

Began with moderate northwesterly
 breeze and fine weather, up to 11 AM
 began to haul light sails about 6 PM
 and deepened the topsails and went to bed. Of
 middle part the same. Latter part light
 breeze & fine weather steering S by E in the
 Molucca passage

Friday Mar 25th

Began with light baffling northwesterly
 breeze and fine weather heading southwesterly.
 Middle part steering S by E. Latter
 part steering S by E. All hands employed
 making ship ready for sea

Saturday Mar 26th

Began with light northwesterly
 breeze and fine weather. Employed making
 the getting up coals and anchoring off the shore.
 Steering S by E. Greenale in sight ahead.
 Middle part the same. Latter part
 light airs. Employed making ship out side

Sunday Mar 27th

Began with light northwesterly and
 fine weather in the mouth of Greenale bay
 At 4 PM anchored off the village.

Monday Mar 28th

Tuesday Mar 29th

Placed in Port. Latter part light baffling
 airs about 11 AM weighed our anchor and started
 out of the port passage. Got the anchor in the shot
 and got dinner.

Master Bk the Molucca passage
 Wednesday Mar 30th

Began with light baffling airs
 At 1 PM light southwesterly breeze heading
 out of the passage. Middle part squally
 steering S by E. Latter part light breeze and fine weather between
 Cypris & Nagai. At 6.30 AM raised a school of
 100 whales off the bow heading to S by E about 4 miles
 off. Boat 11 AM hoisted the boats and ran chase
 At 12.30 the big boat fastened shortly after
 the Starboard boat. Whales started off under the
 other boat after him. So ends chasing whales.

Thursday Mar 31st

Began with light southwesterly breeze
 and fine weather, steering for boats with whales
 At 1.30 PM both whales along side and boats embarked
 At 2.30 hooked on and at 4 PM both whales in
 steering northwesterly. At 1 PM steering S by E
 Middle & Latter part light baffling breeze
 heading northwesterly. At 10 AM finished sailing
 At 12 PM lashed to S by E.

Friday Mar 1st

Began with light baffling northwesterly breeze
 and fine weather heading southwesterly. At 4 PM
 lashed to S by E. At 1 PM lashed again working up
 to Greenale. Middle part fresh breeze, up to 11 PM
 Handed light sails. Latter part light baffling
 breeze. Greenale mountain in sight heading about
 1/4

Saturday Mar 2nd

Began with light baffling breeze and
 pleasant weather heading westward. At 5 PM
 had a heavy squall of wind & rain from S by E.
 Put ship under double reef by 11 PM. Middle
 and Latter part light baffling airs & calms
 making little or no progress.
