

Remarks on board Rk. Dunbar B.

Sunday - Mar 13th

Weather still continues the same.
 About 5 pm had a squall from N. to N. by E.
 ship under double top. Middle part squally.
 Latter part light passing air and calm.
 A Brig in sight heading to S. E.

Monday - Mar 14th

Begins with light northwesterly
 breeze and fine weather heading from S. E.
 to N. Middle & Latter part light air and
 calms

Tuesday - Mar 15th

Begins with light northwesterly air
 and pleasant weather steering N. by E. Middle
 part the same. Latter part from S. E. wind
 about 1 am nearly 20 miles from Kuma lowered
 a boat and started for there about 10.30 am
 and out of sight. About 10 am had a light breeze
 from S. E. steered for Kuma

Wednesday - Mar 16th

Begins with light northwesterly
 breeze and fine weather steering in for
 Kuma about 4 pm hands in about 10 pm
 boat came off. Kept ship. Middle
 part light air and calms. Latter part
 light northwesterly breeze steering N. by E.
 about 10 am vessel suddenly to S. E. saw
 a schooner ahead supposed to be a whaler.

Thursday - Mar 17th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze
 and fine weather steering southwesterly. About
 4 pm spoke the last mentioned schooner
 it proved to be the schooner of Kuma.
 Capt. Baldwin. When spotted out 4 or 5 miles off
 Middle part light northwesterly breeze steering N. by E.
 Latter part light air and calms coaling oil ready for steaming.

Fishes - Waster. In Molucca passage

Friday - Mar 18th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze
 and fine weather steering N. by E. Middle
 part the same. Latter part light air and calms.
 At 1 am commenced breaking out the after-hall
 to stow oil.

Saturday - Mar 19th

Begins with light northwesterly air and
 fine weather steering N. by E. Middle
 part the same. Latter part light air and calms.
 About 5 pm raised keeches off port bow some
 distance off. Did not make it out. Middle
 and Latter part light air and calms.

Sunday - Mar 20th

Begins with light northwesterly air and
 fine weather steering N. by E. Middle
 part the same. Latter part light air and calms.
 At 10 am saw the schooner of Kuma.

Monday - Mar 21st

Begins with light air and calms at 2 pm
 miles off. Whales beginning soon after lowered
 the boat and pulled for them. At about 3 miles
 past before sundown the S. E. boat fastened and killed
 the whale at 4.30 pm all boats on board with whale
 calm weather. Middle part light air heading to S. E.
 Latter part the same. At daylight commenced hauling
 at 6 am raised S. E. whales beginning finished
 cutting about 1 am got breakfast and lowered
 4 boats at 1 am. On board boat specimen to a large
 whale so ends working towards the boats with a
 light air.
