

Remarks on board Rk Plinbeam C. Fisher

Tuesday Mar 22nd

Begins with light air & calms at 12.30 pm boat got to work with whale got dinner and at 1.30 pm began to put at deep speed cutting jaw in and head nearly off. Throwing a little light southwesterly air. Between 8 & 9 pm started the work. Middle part a fine breeze heading eastward employed clearing the decks and boating. Latter part calm and smooth as a mill pond at 6 am called the watch got breakfast and began to cut at 12.30 put whale in.

Wednesday Mar 23rd

Begins with a calm and very hot weather employed cutting up blubber and boiling in case at 4 pm finished the case and got it overboard at back hands in to the water. Middle part light southwesterly breeze with a little rain heading northwesterly finished cutting up the blubber. Latter part the same.

Thursday Mar 24th

Begins with light and variable airs and fine weather. Middle & latter part light northwesterly breeze but at 8 am changed off to bow that about 30 miles still boiling.

Friday Mar 25th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze but at 4 pm finished at dark stored light sails. Middle part the same. Latter part made all sail employed cooping oil to star being down storage & building another forward.

Master cruising in Volusia Passage

Saturday Mar 26th

Begins with pleasant northwesterly breeze steering S by E of a warship. Employed cooping oil. Middle part & latter part light air & calms at daylight made all sail at noon finished cooping oil 25 cask.

Sunday Mar 27th

Begins with light pleasant southerly breeze but at 4 pm a schooner in sight supposed at 4 pm. Middle part light air and calms. The last mention schooner proved to be a cutter instead of a whaler. Latter part light northwesterly breeze steering southwesterly. Different courses.

Monday Mar 28th

Begins with light northwesterly and fine weather steering northwesterly. Different courses at dark steering S by E of a steamer in sight off Port quarter. Latter part light northwesterly breeze steering S by E. Calms part squally with rain began to store oil in all hole.

Tuesday Mar 29th

Begins with fresh ^{rough} breeze and squally working southward. Middle part light and variable winds with rain at 6 am began to store oil in fore hole.

Wednesday Mar 30th

Begins with fresh northwesterly breeze heading to S by E stored 47 bls in fore hole finished storing oil. Latter Mar 29th at 4 pm stored light sails heading eastward. Middle part the same. Latter part made all hands employed storing off between decks light breeze & fine weather.
