

Remarks on board Bk. Dunbar C. Fisher

Tuesday May 4th

Begins with light southeasterly breeze and fine weather heading northwesterly. Went 11 mi. off of whales breaching off together 1/2 mi. off. After 1/2 hr. chased. About 3 PM ship set color for boats to return as the whales are out sight to windward. At 3:30 PM boats embarked. Equally with much thunder and lightning. Middle part light westerly breeze heading to S. by W. after part under way southeasterly breeze by S. by W. heading in for Grubby.

Wednesday May 5th

Begins with light air and calms heading to north and east. At 4 PM squally. Middle part light northerly air steering to S. by W. for Olma bay. After part begins with calms at 10 AM had a light breeze from S. steering S. by W.

Friday May 6th

Begins with light southeasterly breeze. About 1 PM nearly 12 miles from Olma. Towed a boat and the Capt went on shore. About 4 PM boat on board and brought three men which deserted us when we were here before. Report to the Schooner Keyone of Providence. Brought with 280 bbls 13 months out. Equally from S. steering northwesterly different courses to clear the haze. Middle part light air and calms. After part light northeasterly breeze heading to northwesterly at 8 AM landed to S. by W. Capt. sent in sight about 1:30 PM spoke the Barken Volte 4 months out with 100 bbls of oil. Capt. C. went on board a few minutes.

Master Cruising in Cooks Cha.

Thursday May 7th

Begins with light northeasterly and fine weather heading to S. by W. About 12:30 PM left our neighbor the boat to Olma and to Cooks sea. Shortly after landed by S. by W. At 1 PM in the mouth of the str. steering S. by W. Middle & Outer part much the same. Lat 2.24 S Long 123.34 E

Friday May 8th

Begins with light northeasterly breeze by S. by W. Middle & Outer part light northeasterly air steering S. by W. Lat 2.11 S Long 122.28 E

Sunday May 9th

Begins with light and baffling northeasterly fair and pleasant weather steering S. by W. Middle & Outer part the same. Lat 2.00 Long 122.10 E

Monday May 10th

Begins with baffling northeasterly air steering S. by W. Middle & Outer part nearly the same. Bar 30.00. Lat 2.15 S Long 121.41 E

Tuesday May 11th

Begins with light easterly air and pleasant weather steering northwesterly different courses. All hands employed repairing. Middle & Outer part about the same. Lat 2.35 S Long 120.45 E

Wednesday May 12th

Begins with light westerly air by S. by W. At 4 PM finished foretopgail and sent to tip light northwesterly breeze by S. by W. Middle part light southeasterly breeze. Lat 2.27 S heading southeasterly. Outer part about calm. Long 120.20 E
