

Remarks on Board Bk Dunbar R. Fisher

Thursday June 8th

Begins with light westerly air
 heading northwesterly. Middle part the
 sand. Better part moderate breeze
 Lat 3.05 N
 Long 120.05 W

Friday June 10th

Begins with fresh southeasterly
 breeze from N. E. W. hauled light
 sail. At 3:15 pm raised 2 whales breaching
 off the bow distance about 8 miles made
 half sail. About 3:30 pm lowered the boats
 without success, whales going to N. E.
 Middle part light breeze at N. E. W.
 at 1 am looked to N. E. Better part
 commenced with light southerly breeze
 and rain steering N. E. at 8 am light
 air and calm. One sail in sight Lat 3.27 N
 Long 119.47 W

Saturday June 11th

Begins with light air and
 calm. Middle part light breeze at
 N. E. W. Better part about
 the same. Heavy current setting to
 N. W. grampisks in sight Lat 3.17 N
 Long 119.25 W

Sunday June 12th

Begins with light westerly air
 baffling heading from N. E. W. to N. E.
 Middle and Better part nearly the same
 Lat 3.22 N
 Long 119.23 W

Monday June 13th

Begins with light baffling air
 and calm. Begins to get eastward making
 little or no progress having a strong head
 current. Middle part light breeze at N. E. W.
 to N. E. Better part light baffling
 breeze with squalls. One merchant ship in sight

Tuesday June 14th

Begins with light baffling
 air at 8 am light breeze at N. E. W.
 to N. E. Middle part
 light breeze at N. steering N. Better
 part wind veered to N. W. by 4 pm
 moderate breeze at 10 am
 fresh breeze, hoisted light sails.
 One neighbor in sight to leeward
 no observation

Wednesday June 15th

Begins with strong breeze
 at 8 am at 1 pm darkened in the foretopsail
 at 3 pm reefed the main brig N. E.
 Middle part steering N. E. W. at 8 pm raised
 the land. Better part light northeasterly
 breeze with some rain at 8 am hoisted the
 tops. Breeze looked to N. W. weather
 Lat 1.42 N
 Long 120.51 W

Thursday June 16th

Begins with light northeasterly
 breeze and fine weather by 4 pm N. E. W.
 Middle part the same. Better part
 light air and calm Lat 2.51 N
 Long 120.19 W

Friday June 17th

Begins with light westerly breeze
 and squalls steering N. E. W. to N. E.
 Middle part the same about 10 am wind veered
 to N. E. Better part splendid weather
 by 4 pm N. E. W.
 Lat 3.00 N
 Long 120.21 W
