Sunday June 26th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze
 hup S.W. Then a merchant vessel steering
 to S.W. at dark shortened sail & middle
 part steering to latter part equally
 from S heading to S.W. two sail in
 sight

 Long 119 52 W

Monday June 27th

Begins with light breeze at S.W.
 hup S at dark shortened & middle part
 of breeze at S. 12 M more to S.W. &
 latter part steering S finished stowage oil
 in fore hold. Then the breeze steering to S.W.

Lat 2 21 N
 Long 119 13 W

Tuesday June 28th

Begins with light easterly breeze
 and fine weather steering S.W. employed
 breaking out between decks taking account
 of provisions at dark banded light sails
 and more to S.W. A merchant vessel
 in sight steering to S.W. middle & latter
 part the same at 4 M more to S.W.

Lat 1 55 N
 Long 119 32 W

Wednesday June 29th

Begins with light northwesterly
 breeze, and pleasant weather steering
 southwesterly & latter part the same
 latter part light hup, and at daylight
 Cape Mice in sight bearing about S.W. &
 heading in towards the land Cape Mice in sight
 instead of us

Thursday June 30th

Begins with light northwesterly
 breeze and fine weather steering for the
 land, about 8 M spoke the Hesperian
 Galle and Joseph & Agnew's Conci
 light northwesterly breeze hup to S.W.
 middle part southwesterly breeze hup
 to S.W. & latter part northwesterly
 breeze hup to S.W.

Friday July 1st

Begins with light breeze at S.W.
 and fine weather hup to S at dark more
 to S.W. and shortened sail. At 10 M
 in sight off her quarter. Middle &
 latter part the same

Lat 1 50 N
 Long 120 17 W

Saturday July 2d

Begins with light breeze at
 S.W. and pleasant weather hup
 to S at sundown banded light sails
 middle part light breeze and calm
 latter part light easterly breeze hup
 to S

Lat 1 44 N
 Long 120 15 W

Sunday July 3d

Begins with light northwesterly
 breeze heading to S.W. at dark shorter
 sails middle part working into
 same course S.W. at daylight
 Cape Mice bearing S.W. 20 miles
 latter part light breeze to S

Lat 1 20 N
 Long 120 30 W

Monday July 4th

Begins with light northwesterly
 breeze and fine weather hup to S.W.
 at dark shorter light sails heading
 to S.W. middle part light breeze &
 rain latter part light breeze and calm
 about 20 miles off Cape Mice
