

Remarks onboard Rk Dunham B. Fisher.

Tuesday July 27th

Begins with fresh westerly breezes steering in for settlement with Halkteen. At 5 PM lowered a boat from pack vessel and went ashore. At dark boats came onboard jammed with Halkteen until 8 PM and separated. Latter part lost sight of Halkteen thick and rainy from 10 PM.

Wednesday July 28th

Begins with fresh northwesterly breezes working westward. Middle & Latter part much the same. Lat 72° 1' N Long 123° 58' W

Friday July 29th

Begins with light-southerly breezes. Lat 72° 1' N. cooling oil to stove. Middle & Latter part light and variable air steamed 22 lbs of oil in fore R. way. No observation.

Saturday July 30th

Begins with light and baffling wind with light squalls of rain. At 4:30 PM saw 4 whales going quick to N. lowered 4 boats with but no success. At 7 PM all boats onboard. shortened sail headed to S. E. & N. Middle part the same. Latter part westerly breezes heading northwesterly thick fog saw a sail to windward supposed to be a whale. no observation.

Sunday July 31st

Begins with light northwesterly breezes heading southwesterly at 4 PM very squally spalled reflect, took in fore and main sail at dark cleared up the fore & main. Thick and rainy. Middle part more moderate at 8 PM was to have made some sail. Latter part light air. Lat Long

Master Cruising in Polar Sea

Monday Aug 1st

Begins with light southwesterly breezes and fine weather heading northwesterly at 5 PM steering to N. E. Middle part the same at daylight. Crown Island in sight - bearing about S. by E. Latter part moderate breezes at 10 km squally from West over to E. under double reefs.

Tuesday Aug 2nd

Begins with strong westerly breezes. Lat 72° 1' N. in squally rain. Middle & Latter part light baffling air and calm. Lat 72° 09' N Long 120° 58' W

Wednesday Aug 3rd

Begins with light air and calms. Middle & Latter part the same. Crown Island still in sight - bearing about S. by E. Steamship in sight.

Thursday Aug 4th

Begins with light baffling air and pleasant weather heading southward. Middle part light-southerly breezes with some rain. Lat 72° 09' N. Latter part wind over to S. E. at 8 PM backed to N. Lat 72° 44' N Long 120° 00' W

Friday Aug 5th

Begins with light-southerly breezes and fine weather steering S. by E. at 5 PM southerly breeze. Lat 72° 44' N. Middle part moderate breeze at 8 PM steering S. E. at daylight. Crown Island in sight. Latter part steered S. by E. for land. no observation in sight.
