

Remarks on board Bk Dunham C. Fisher
Tuesday Aug 23rd

Begins with light air and calm, at 4 PM toward for Blackfish about 4.30 PM boats on board without success. Weathering weather headed light sails steering N by E. at dark double reefed. Middle part light southeasterly breeze at 11 PM luffed to by W. at 12 PM up to 1/2 N. Gally part the same at daylight. Boat shut off shortly after passed a sail, supposed to be a whaler. About 12 am spoke the Bk Hathorn had taken 35 bbls of oil since we last saw her.

Wednesday Aug 24th

Begins with light air and calm in company with Hathorn heading northwesterly. Middle & Gally part at daylight still continues light. Hathorn in sight off boat quarter.

Thursday Aug 25th

Begins with light westerly air and pleasant weather. Steering N by E. at 4 PM our neighbor out of sight at dark shortened sail steering E. Middle part the same. Gally part light air and calm.

Friday Aug 26th

Begins with light air and calm at 4 PM light westerly breeze by W at dark furled light sails. Middle part northwesterly breeze steering N by W. Gally part baffling breeze heading northwesterly.

Master Cruising in Molucca Passage of N.S. Co
Saturday Aug 27th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze and fine weather heading northwesterly at dark weathering weather headed light sails. A merchantman in sight steering southward. At 1 PM rain with baffling air. Middle part light breeze at 4 PM luffed to 1/2 N. Gally part baffling air & calm. Two merchant vessels in sight steering southward.

Sunday Aug 28th

Begins with light variable air. At 5.30 PM boarded the Spanish Bk Maria of Malaga 22 days from Manila bound to Oadiz. Loaded with coffee & sugar. Light easterly breeze steering N by E. Middle part the same. Gally part light southerly breeze steering N by E. At 10 am luffed to by W.

Monday Aug 29th

Begins with light southerly breeze and fine weather by W. At 4 PM at dark double reefed. Gradually fresh to 1/2 N. Middle part light breeze at 4 PM more to 1/2 N. Gally part the same at daylight more to 1/2 N. squalls & squalls in sight.

Tuesday Aug 30th

Begins with light breeze at 4 PM and fine weather by W. At 4 PM luffed to 1/2 N. at dark headed light sails steering N by E. Middle part the same. Gally part moderate easterly breeze steering N by W. all hands employed repairing & mending.
