

Remarks on board Rk Chubram C. Fisher

Wednesday Aug 31st

Begins with light easterly breeze and fine weather steering N by E at 4 PM. Reached main point and left it at 5 PM. Baffling breeze with some rain. Middle part light easterly breeze. At 1:30 am more light S.W. Weather the same.

Thursday Sept 1st

Begins with light air and calm. Middle part light breeze S by E steering. At 10 AM. Better part light easterly breeze heading northward. At 11 am. No. 10. S.W. Gale in sight bearing about N.

Friday Sept 2d

Begins with light northwesterly breeze heading southward. At 3 PM. Baffling breeze with rain. Banded light sails. Middle & Better part light southerly breeze heading in shore by 10 PM.

Saturday Sept 3d

Begins with light southerly breeze & fine weather heading in for N. 10. At 1 PM. S.W. about 3 PM. wind veered suddenly to S.W. Middle & Better part light easterly breeze by 4 PM. at 2 am. backed to N. backed off shore at daylight at 10 am. southerly breeze by 10 PM. heading in for south point of Singapore.

Master. Cruising in Molucca Passage.

Sunday Sept 4th

Begins with light southerly breeze and fine weather heading southward along the land. Middle & Better part light northwesterly breeze steering. At 10 PM. South point of N. 10. bearing about N.

Monday Sept 5th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze & fine weather steering about N by E at sunset steering N. By 10 PM. major bearing about N. 10. Middle part the same. Better part baffling air and calm.

Tuesday Sept 6th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze and fine weather heading northwesterly at 3.30 PM. wind veered northward. backed to N. Middle part light westerly breeze by 4 PM. at 4 PM. wind veered southward. to 5 PM. by 5 PM. part baffling breeze with squally workings westward. Saw a large vessel did not make it out.

Wednesday Sept 7th

Begins with light southerly breeze and fine weather heading N by E at 1 PM. raised a sail of the bow-sloop and to be a whaler. at 3 PM. wind veered to N. 10. steered N.W. about 6 PM. spoke the ship "Hathlyn" and taken 28 lbs. of oil since we last saw her. Two merchantmen in sight working southward. Middle part by 10 PM. "Hathlyn" close to all night. Better part the same. at 8 am. lowered a boat and took out "Hathlyn" mate to the "Hathlyn" to take to Singapore on account of sickness. About 11 am. sighted a French ship light southerly breeze by 10 PM.
