

Remarks on board Bk. Panbeam U.

Monday Oct 24th

Begins with moderate westerly breeze steering S at 8 PM wind veered to E with rain and double reef. Middle part the same. Latter part baffling air and calm. Light east of Celebes in sight to the S. about 65 miles off. Lat 2.22 N Long 120.00 E

Tuesday Oct 25th

Begins with baffling air and calm. Middle part light breeze steering S. Latter part steering S by E. Lat 1.48 N Long 120.00 E

Wednesday Oct 26th

Begins with light westerly breeze steering S by E. At dark Cape Bores being 20 miles. Middle part light breeze steering S. Latter part baffling air and calm. Cape Bores in sight. A schooner in sight.

Thursday Oct 27th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze and fine weather steering S by E. At 8 PM wind veered to E with rain. Middle part the same. Latter part clear weather steering S by E. Lat 1.28 N Long 122.00 E

Friday Oct 28th

Begins with light westerly breeze and fine weather steering S by E. Middle & Latter part the same. Lat 1.06 N Long 122.22 E

Fisher & Master On Molucca passage.

Saturday Oct 29th

Begins with light westerly breeze and fine weather steering S by E. At 8 PM fresh breeze with the wind weather handed light sails steering S by E. Middle part light breeze made some sail. Latter part fresh breeze and squall from N & E. Middle part light sails steering S by E. Cape in sight ahead. Blackfish in sight.

Sunday Oct 30th

Begins with fresh breeze at 8 AM steering S by E. At 1 PM hands into E. Luff to S by E and double reefed the topsails. Middle part moderate breeze at 11 PM in Molucca passage. Breeze in sight begins about 2 PM. Latter part fresh breeze steering S by E. Cape & Bores in sight.

Monday Oct 31st

Begins with moderate southeasterly breeze from S by E & S by E at 8 PM fresh breeze double reefed the topsails & hand down. Latter part the same with some rain. Celebes & Celebes in sight. Working southward. Lat & Long.

Tuesday Nov 1st

Begins with moderate southeasterly breeze from S by E & S by E at 8 PM. Latter part wind veered to N by E. At 8 PM wind veered to S by E. Latter part light breeze at 11 AM had a heavy squall from N & E with much rain. Cape in sight bearing about S by E.
