

Remarks on board Bk. Danmark O. Fisher

Sunday Nov 20th

Began with baffling air & calm with some rain. At 7 PM light-southeast breeze by N. E. N. Middle and latter part the same. At 12 am backed off shore by N. E.

Monday Nov 21st

Began with light-southeast breeze by N. E. N. Middle part equally with rain. Latter part light-southeast breeze and fine weather by N. E.

Tuesday Nov 22nd

Began with light-southeast breeze and fine weather by N. E. N. Middle part equally with rain. Latter part light-southeast breeze heading in shore by N. E. N.

Wednesday Nov 23rd

Began with light-northwest breeze by N. E. N. Middle & latter part light-air & calm. Fine southerly current

Thursday Nov 24th

Began with light-southeast breeze air & calm heading northward. At 1 PM light-northwest breeze by N. E. N. Middle & latter part about the same. Trying to get off the north point of the island making very little progress. Light southerly current. Went down the bay to repair

Friday Nov 25th

Began with light-northwest breeze and fine weather by N. E. N. Middle part the same at 2 am backed to N. E. N. Latter part calm. At 11 am light-southeast breeze steering N. by N.

Saturday Nov 26th

Began with light-southeast breeze steering N. by N. At 12 PM wind veered northwest with squalls and much rain. Handed light-sail at 5 PM fresh breeze under double reef by N. E. N. Middle part moderate breeze made some sail. Latter part light-northwest breeze under all sail by N. E. N. At 11:30 am chased whales off weather beam about 10 miles off supposed to be off whales

Sunday Nov 27th

Began with fresh westerly breeze by N. E. N. Middle part light-sail working up to whales which are backing away for minutes. About 8 PM saw spouts about 4 PM whales little over a mile off, weather bow, doubled up about 12 the boats and fanned the boat. Shortly after distance the Starboard boat fastened then the Weatherboard 50 degree and Bow boat. The Starboard boat fastened from here about. At 8 PM all boats on board and whales made fast ship heading southward. Middle part moderate breeze getting ready for cutting. Latter part about the same at daylight looked over and at 1 am whales in. Got breakfast were to N. E. N. and started the work. All hands employed clearing decks. At midnight flukes cut up and decks washed off.
