

Remarks on board Bk. Canbeam. V.

Monday Nov 28th Begins with light air and calm. At sunset a Merchant man in sight steering eastward. Middle part light northwesterly breeze by 11 P.M. at 1 P.M. about 3 P.M. finished boiling. Latter part light northwesterly breeze by 1 P.M. at 7.30 more to P.M.

Tuesday Nov 29th Begins with light air & calm at 2 P.M. took a moderate breeze at 4 P.M. by P.M. at dusk parted all light sails. Middle part light air & calm. Latter part the same. Bent down the fore top S. sail to repair.

Wednesday Nov 30th Begins with light air & calm. Finished repairing last mentioned sail and bent it - at 2 P.M. light northwesterly breeze by 1 P.M. & 1 P.M. Middle part northwesterly breeze by 1 P.M. Latter part light breeze at 1 P.M. by 1 P.M. Bent a new top S. mast ready to send up.

Thursday Dec 1st Begins with light westerly breeze and fine weather by 1 P.M. at 5 P.M. squally with some rain doubled up the topsails. Middle part light westerly breeze by 1 P.M. Latter part fresh breeze with squalls at 10 am. split the jib. Bent it in to repair. A boat in sight from mast head bearing about P.M.

Fisher & Master. Cruising off Nootka P. C. O.

Friday Dec 2d Begins with fresh westerly breeze by 1 P.M. at 1 P.M. finished repairing jib and bent it. at 5 P.M. wind veered to N.W. more to N.E. Middle part about the same. Latter part moderate breeze heading in for Nootka by 1 P.M. by 1 P.M.

Saturday Dec 3d Begins with moderate at 1 P.M. by 1 P.M. at 2 P.M. had a heavy squall at 1 P.M. with much rain hauled light sails and set the topsails on to cap. After squall made sail and more to N. light northwesterly breeze. Middle part moderate breeze at 1 P.M. more to N.W. about 1 P.M. had a very heavy westerly squall. Split the Spanker and attached the main topmast in several places. Latter part light breeze heading to P.M. Employed working out for Spanker & Cordage at 11 am more to N.W.

Sunday Dec 4th Begins with light air and calm employed working Spanker & repairing maintop sail. at 1 P.M. fresh breeze under double reef. Middle part breeze increasing at 3 am hauled up the courses and closed up the topsails. Latter part more moderate at the courses jib & Spanker. about 11 am lost sight of Nootka.

Monday Dec 5th Begins with fresh westerly breeze and squally about 11 am took in jib & Spanker at 5 P.M. finished the courses & gaff. sails more to N.W. Middle part about the same. Latter part more moderate at the courses jib & Spanker. Sat 2.30 P.M.
