

Remarks on board Bk Dunbar D. Fisher

Monday Jan 16th

Begins with light air & calm
heading to westward. Middle part about the
same. Latter part light northwesterly breeze
bup 1/2 to 1/4 N. E. The 10 miles of the
heading about the same.

Tuesday Jan 17th

Begins with light northwesterly
breeze and fine weather bup 1/2 to 1/4 N. E.
at 4 PM shifts the 10. sails away to S. E.
Middle part goes to 1/2 to 1/4 N. E. Latter part
light easterly breeze steering 1/2 N. E. to
landward. North point of Woody bearing
about 1/2 N.

Wednesday Jan 18th

Begins with light easterly
breeze and pleasant weather steering 1/2 N. E. in
at 4 PM shifts the 10. steers to 1/2 N. E. Middle
part light breeze 1/2 N. E. steering 1/2 N. E.
Latter part steers 1/2 N.

Thursday Jan 19th

Begins with light northeasterly
breeze weather overcast steering 1/2 N. E. in
company. Middle part in heavy breeze
at midnight steers 1/2 N. E. daylight climate
in sight bearing about 1/2 N. E. 10 leagues
steers for it. Latter part the same 10.
in company. Got the anchors off the bow.

Friday Jan 20th

Begins with light northeasterly
breeze and fine weather steering 1/2 N. E. for
the north passage. At 4 PM the north passage
and sails pulled to wind and doubled up.

First boat bearing 1/2 N. E. dist. 2 leagues Middle (10) vessels
part squally with rain at 11 PM steers off for the passage. Latter
part part light breeze of 10 at 10 AM came to anchor in
10 fathoms water found the Kallien a French bark and several small boats.

Master, Bk. Arctura Passage bound to Hema.

Saturday Jan 21st

At anchor in Bernate good weather
the first part. Light squalls of rain the middle
part. Latter part got a raft of 15 bbls ashore
to fill with water good weather.

Sunday Jan 22nd

First part got off 15 bbls of ^{water} and
steered it. Latter part 1/2 N. E. on 10 fathoms
fine weather.

Monday Jan 23rd

Pleasant weather with fresh breeze
got off 10 bbls of potatoes & food.

Tuesday Jan 24th

Latter part moderate breeze at 10 PM 1/2
and pleasant weather at 9 AM got underway and
steered out through the S. Passage.

Wednesday Jan 25th

Begins with moderate northeasterly
breeze bup 1/2 to 1/4 N. E. Middle part much
the same. Latter part baffling air and calm.
Hema mountain in sight bearing about 1/2 N.

Thursday Jan 26th

Begins with light air and calm
at 4 PM light northeasterly breeze bup 1/2 to 1/4 N. E.
Middle part about the same. Latter part
light air and calm 1/2 N. E. steers to
landward.

Friday Jan 27th

Begins with light baffling air
and calm Middle part the same. Latter
part continues the same and very warm. Arrived
off the coast of Celebes in sight
the Malay vessel also. Lat 0.44 N.
