

Remarks on board Bk Dunham B. Fisher

Saturday Jan 28

at 7 pm light northeast breeze fresh
S.W. & S.E. & gradually past the same
Gather part light weather breeze strong
N.E. & S.W. & some mountain in sight ahead.

Sunday Jan 27th

Monday Jan 21st Begins with light south-easterly
breezes steering S by E. at 4 PM light
also & calms our neighbor in sight off S by E
quarter. Middle & latter part light airs
and calms. Bema being about 20 dist.
15-20 miles

Monday Jan 30th

Begin with light easterly breeze
up Oct 10 Sat. dock our neighbor in sight -
takes another sail. & Windy part moderate
westerly breeze up 11.25 Oct 11
Calter part falling breeze with squalls
off the mouth of St. Berna bay both of
these neighbors in sight working up. Boat
Edm. lowered a boat and Capt. St. went
on shore ship still working up so early.

Sunday Jan 8th

Begin with light baffling breezes and pleasant weather about 8 miles off shore. At 2 pm boat came off with others at 4.30 pm, anchored in 8 fathoms water. Shortly after a Duck Lin came to anchor & boddle past Measent land breezes. Later part of same getting off some recruits. Basketeer inside.

Wednesday Feb 1st

7. " Begins with pleasant land breezes
getting off early requests about 12.30 pm. H. station
and Lt. anchor taking bad. Harris to pump
every hour, making about 1. Sixes per hour
Middle part land breezes. Latter part light air
at daylight lowered three boats and pulled the
S. Her. hand in, anchored in S. Father's water
29. 10 am. fresh breeze.

Thursday Feb 2d

Begin with fish traps about
5 PM weighed long and stowed out for bay
under topsails. Let the anchor into shoe and
get supper. At dark doubled reefed about 8 PM
luffed to wind by 10 & 11 PM & 12 AM. 14.
Fast squally with rain. Batten fast light
buffing air working southward along the land
simplyed getting anchors out of hold and stowing
cable below.

Friday Feb 3d

"Begin with light air & calm"
 34 fm took a light - misty, breeze slight
 & 2 middle part fresh, and breeze, headed
 light sails. Latter part light air again, very
 little progress against a strong northerly current
 a merchant brig in sight - working northward.
 through the passage.

Belmont Feb 4th

Boats with a light on each. Pass
steering D. W. L. P. & Middle & after first light
are and calm. Saw Blackbird & grampolies
