

Remarks on board the *Plumbeum* C. Foster.

Sunday Feb 5th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze steering 270° at 7 AM wind veered to 270° at dark shortened sail at 4 PM wind veered to 270° with much rain a squally part rainy, much weather at 4 AM shifted to wind then 10° latter part light northwesterly breeze steering southwesterly pleasant weather

Monday Feb 6th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze and fine weather steering 270° at 1 PM wind veered to 270° at dark. Off coast of Poela in sight a line a squally part weather continues the same. Latter part 270° heading in for the latter which are in sight

Tuesday Feb 7th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze 270° at 1.30 PM quite heavy the land cleared southward along it. Shortened sail at dark and shifted to wind 270° at 10 PM. Point of 10° C. G. G. G. bearing 270° at 8 PM begins to make round sail along southern current a squally part much the same at 12 PM gone inshore at 5 PM heavy to land now off shore latter part baffling breeze

Wednesday Feb 8th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze 270° at 2 PM had a squally part 270° at 4 PM handed all sail except deck reefs a squally part light northwesterly breeze steering 270° latter part steered 270° at 10 PM. Clear grandpolder

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Thursday Feb 9th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze steering 270° at 6 PM steering 270° by the Siemalata bearing about 270° by 10° Middle & latter part weather much the same steering 270° at 10 PM. Clear a great many Blaphish.
Lat $15^{\circ} 29'$
Long $127^{\circ} 29'$

Friday Feb 10th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze and fine weather steering 270° at 10 AM dark steered 270° . South point of Poela Basi bearing about 270° by 10° a squally part. Latter part baffling air and calm off the passage between Boro and Poela Basi.

Saturday Feb 11th

Begins with baffling air and calm at 4 PM light & light northwesterly breeze steering 270° through the passage. Two Merchant vessels in sight working northward. Middle part baffling breeze at daybreak no sail in sight. Latter part fine, eastward breeze steering 270° by 10 employed breaking out with coo-fishing oil between decks no sail in sight.

Sunday Feb 12th

Begins pleasant easterly breeze steering 270° by 10. Clear sail in sight a squally part much the same at 3 AM had a squally part 270° under short reefs. Latter part baffling air two 270° in sight.
Lat $15^{\circ} 25'$
Long $127^{\circ} 24'$
