

Remarks on board Bk Dunbar W. Fisher

Monday Feb 15th

Begins with pleasant - easterly
breezes and fine weather steering N. by E.
Middle part squally with rain steering N.
Latter part light breeze the object of
Hawaii a head. Lat. 12° 35' N
Long 153° 35' W

Tuesday Feb 16th

Begins with puffing northwesterly
breezes heading southwesterly. Wind to backshift.
At dark shortened sail and steered S.
Middle part light air and calm. Latter part
light puffing air steering S. by N. head
into harbor.

Wednesday Feb 17th

Begins with light - northwesterly
breezes and pleasant weather steering S. by E.
along Boston shore. Middle part puffing
air with rain squalls at daylight. Whangi
in sight. Whangi S. by E. 1/2 S. also a
Sperdant Bk in sight working northward.
Latter part calm about 7.30 am raised
a fine Sph whale sping to the S. N. shortly
after. Lured the boats and gave chase
to ends.

Thursday Feb 18th

Weather still continues calm.
Boats in pursuit of whale at 8 am all boats
on board with great success. Middle part light
northwesterly breezes by 4 pm S. by E. at 4 pm
lured to S. N. Latter part light air and
calm. one Sperdant Bk and several Malay
Boats in sight. Saw grampies.

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Friday Feb 19th

Begins with light - southwesterly
breezes steering S. by E. at 6 pm head by hunter
squall with rain from N. headed light sails.
Middle part calm. Latter part puffing
air heading in shore.

Saturday Feb 20th

Begins with light - northwesterly
breezes by 10.30 am at 11 am had a
squall with rain from N. headed S. by E.
Middle part northwesterly breezes. Latter part
northwesterly breezes at 4 pm raised Sph whale
off weather but luffed by wind. At 8.15 am
lured the boats whaling working
to windward. Objects chasing whale.
Whangi Whangi bearing S. N.

Sunday Feb 21st

Begins with pleasant northwesterly
breezes spilt by pursuit of whales at 8.15 am.
Indist boat fastened the rest of the whales
started to windward. and the other boats
gave chase but returned at 6 pm with out
further success. off boats on board and whale
made fast. Bright morning breeze passing to
S. N. Middle part squally with much rain.
Latter part pleasant northwesterly breezes at daylight
began to cut. at 1 am when it made some squall by
S. N. at 10 am whale cut up and decks washed
off. Parted the work about 8 am. at 12 am
Washed to S. N.

Monday Feb 22nd

Begins with pleasant northwesterly
breezes and variable at 4 pm lashed to S. N. S. by E.
At 11 pm squally headed light sails and lashed
to S. N. by 10 am northwesterly making little or
no progress because of a strong head current. Middle
part at other continues the same. finished by 11.15 am
Latter part fine breeze but lowering ground off S. N. weather clear.
