

Remarks on Board. Bk Chubbeam. Vⁿ

Tuesday Feb 21st

Begin with light northwesterly breeze. Wind to pass to southward of us & baffles. Strongly & suddenly part calm. Baffles part light northwesterly breeze making it most impossible to pass to windward. At 8 am, passed to leeward of it moderate breeze. Baffles 2 1/2 to 3 miles about 40 am looked to the N. W. Two birds in sight.

Wednesday Feb 22d

"Begins with light weather,
 keeps and fine weather until 11 AM,
 passed to N & W getting up, the S side, of
 Mt. & weather calm morning, no more looks.
 Middle part the same. Latter part moderate
 breeze gust to N & the Island bearing N $1\frac{1}{2}$

Thursday Feb 23d

Thursday Dec. 23rd "Begin with light northeast breeze at 11th
lacked by 12th P. M. at 8.30 A.M. started to N. & N. W. side
past Cape Horn. 12th P. M. past moderate breeze
at daylight - strong breeze in sight bearing - Round
H. 184

Friday Feb 4th

Today Oct 27th "Begin with moderate northeast
breezes and pleasant weather by 11 A.M.
At 2.30 P.M. started to Port Hope at daylight
The Walker's were leaving about 10 P.M.
Middle part squally with fresh northwesterly
breezes heading from 200 to 250 P.M. at daylight
The Walker's were leaving Port Hope. Bottom part
moderate breezes by 1 P.M. Lat 4.78°

Fisher, Master. Cruising off Boston. P. Band.

Saturday Aug 25th

Begins with fish traps at N. N. E.
and pleasant weather. Capt. & C. Cooperd oil
to star. & 48 Blm. tried to the N. E. light buoy
made 4800 sails. No doubt part another of same
Galley part of m. & 18 lbs oil in after hatch
between decks. Sat. 4.30 P.M.

Long 124.26 E

Sunday Feb 28th

Begin with fine weather
 breeze and pleasant weather temp. 78° & 76° at 9 am wind veered to 210° temp. 76° & 74° at 11 am. Fresh breeze & light S.W. part the same. At daylight saw the Island of Booby. Sp. birds flying about it. Later part light breeze heading in towards the land.

Monday Feb 27th

Monday Nov 27th "Begin with Norwest-southwest
breeze blowing in towards the land. At 11 A.M.
about 25 miles from it, light squalls subsided &
drifted off half way to W about 4 M. rose to 6 A.M.
at daylight off of point of Boston. Better part
fresh breeze about 6 A.M. raised off whaler from
deck off weather beam going to seaward at 8.15 am
sailed 4 boats at 9.30 am left boat fastened
shortly after the hour. The end

Closed Feb 28th

begins with fresh northwest
breeze and pleasant weather, at 2 P.M. all
boats on board and whale made fast. At 2.30 P.M.
began to cut; finished cutting and washed off
blubber left deck. Got blubber stored and
and was to 4 P.M. at 7 P.M. started the groggs.
Middle part fresh breeze employed boiling and
churning; deck at 1 A.M. was all P. P. L. then put
light breeze up E & S.W. 1/4. Rang rangi and
Booted in sight.
