

Remarks on board Bk. Gunbeam, D. Fisher.

Friday & Mar 10th
 Begins with light air & calm with a strong westerly employed setting up rigging. At 4 pm took a light breeze, weather clear, light S by E. Middle part about the same. Latter part wind veered to S by E by 10 P. M. at 12 am backed to S by E.

Saturday & Mar 11th
 Begins with light easterly breeze and pleasant weather. At 4 pm took a middle part the same. At 8 am backed to S by E. Latter part baffling air and calm in the forenoon.

Sunday & Mar 12th
 Begins with baffling air & calm working northward. Middle part light southeasterly breeze steering S by E. Latter part light northerly breeze heading northwesterly. Quiescent bearing about 2 1/2 N by E.

Monday & Mar 13th
 Begins with light northwesterly breeze by 4 pm S by E. At 5 pm squall with rain in the mouth of the Woodcock passage. Middle part northerly breeze by 10 am. Latter part wind veered westward at 10 am backed to S by E. Saw a Chinook.

Tuesday & Mar 14th
 Begins with light westerly breeze by 4 pm S by E. At 7 pm baffling breeze with squalls under double reef. Middle part northerly breeze by 10 am. At 10 am backed to S by E. Latter part the same at 10 pm squall from westward with much rain, thunder and lightning. Kargolung bearing about 2 1/2 N by E.

Remarks. Cruising in a Woodcock passage of 2 N. S. Long.

Wednesday & Mar 15th
 Begins with light northwesterly breeze and rain. Heading northward. At dark squall. Middle part wind veered northward. Backed to S by E. Moderate breeze at daylight. Headed into S by E. Spent the latter part moderate northwesterly breeze heading southeasterly. At 10 am had a heavy squall from S by E. were to S by E. headed all day except two double reefs. Wind southerly current.

Thursday & Mar 16th
 Begins with light northwesterly breeze and pleasant weather. At 4 pm took a middle part light southeasterly breeze at 10 miles. Middle part light breeze at 2 1/2 N by E. At 10 am at daylight S by E. bearing S. dist 40 miles or thereabouts. Latter part weather about the same. Departed 4 1/2 pm.

Friday & Mar 17th
 Begins with light air and calm. At 5 pm had a squall from S by E. Middle part wind veered to S by E. by 10 pm light breeze. Latter part moderate breeze.

Saturday & Mar 18th
 Begins with moderate northerly breeze and pleasant weather. At 4 pm employed repairing. At 7 pm finished. Middle part wind veered to S by E. Steered S by E. Latter part moderate breeze at 4 pm. At 11 1/2 pm third V. M. whales breaching off weather bar about 8 miles off. At end, doubling up to whales. Cape Blossed bearing about 2 1/2 N by E. dist 60 miles. Lat. 30 N.
