

Remarks on board Bk. Quabam V. Fisher.

Sunday Apr 23d

Begins with light and variable breeze and some rain steering S by E 2 1/2 m light air at 4 1/2 m the land appears S by E for Panama. Weather overcast & slightly fresh and round to S by E at daylight and to Boer and finding the current setting westward kept ship S by E for the passage between Ogelsa River and Boer. Latter part light northerly air.

Monday Apr 24th

Begins with light northerly air steering southward. Different course at 5 m laid round to S by E by 1/2 m moderate breeze headed some of the light sails a middle part light air under all sail by 1/2 m. Latter part wind round to S by E and S by E to the land. Employed coopers oil to show.

Tuesday Apr 25th

Begins with light northerly breeze with variable weather steering S by E employed as fast as possible. at 2 1/2 m finished coopers. Fresh breeze with much rain headed light sails. At 6 m light northerly breeze and thick weather steering S by E under all sail. Middle part wind round to S by E by 1/2 m. Latter part wind about the same and pleasant weather. Placed down 5 1/2 m S by E at between decks about 1/2 m hatch.

Master On the Bk. Quabam V. Fisher and bound.

Wednesday Apr 26th

Begins with light southerly breeze and pleasant weather by 1/2 m. Ship got down off 1/2 m hatch and weather ship. At 1 1/2 m fresh from S headed light sails a middle part continue the same with some rain at daylight the state of Quabam in sight from masthead bearing about S by E. Latter part light air and overcast weather steering S by E.

Long 125.25 W

Thursday Apr 27th

Begins with light southerly breeze with light rain by 1/2 m. Middle part some squally by 1/2 m. Latter part moderate breeze and pleasant weather employed repairing for topsail.

Lat 9.18 N
Long 124.58 W

Friday Apr 28th

Begins with fresh easterly breeze and pleasant weather by 1/2 m. at 1 1/2 m headed some of the light sails. Middle part weather much the same steering S by E at 12 m wind moderate. By 1/2 m air at daylight the state of Quabam in sight. Latter part bearing S by E dist 12 leagues or thereabouts. Latter part fresh easterly breeze by 1/2 m. At 12 am headed some of the light sails.

Saturday Apr 29th

Begins with fresh easterly breeze and pleasant weather by 1/2 m. at 1 1/2 m headed some of the light sails. Passed between the island of Quabam & Panama steering S by E at 5 m steering S by E. The passage low. Quabam back & Blackpt. Middle part weather much the same. Latter part light air and calm at 10.30 am passed Barbados boat for Blackpt. returned without success.
