

Remarks on board Bk. Pinkham O. Fisher.

Saturday May 20th

Begins with fresh trades and pleasant weather steering N. by E. Middle & latter part continues about the same. Lat. 18.25 N Long 77.11 W

Sunday May 21st

Begins with fresh trades and splendid weather steering N. by E. Middle part wind unsteady. Latter part moderate breezes. Lat 18.13 N Long 76.07 W

Monday May 22nd

Begins with moderate trades and pleasant weather steering N. by E. Middle & latter part about the same. Lat 18.46 N Long 75.02 W

Tuesday May 23rd

Begins with light trades and fine weather steering N. Middle and latter part much the same. Lat 17.00 N Long 70.15 W

Wednesday May 24th

Begins with light trades and splendid weather steering N. by E. Middle & latter part continues about the same. Lat 17.17 N Long 67.48 W

Thursday May 25th

Trades still continues light and baffling steering N. by E. Middle part the same. Latter part splendid weather steering N. Lat 17.04 N Long 66.21 W

Friday May 26th

Trades still continues light with beautiful weather steering N. Middle part equally with baffling weather breeze freshening somewhat. Latter part pleasant weather and light breeze by. Lat 18.41 N Long 63.54 W

Saturday May 27th

Begins with light westerly breeze by. Lat 18.41 N Long 63.54 W. Saw a sail off the bow which proved to be a Portuguese man-of-war westward. Middle & latter part baffling air and calm. One last mentioned sail in sight astern. Lat 17.48 N Long 64.52 W

Sunday May 28th

Begins with light squally breeze and pleasant weather by. N. by E. Middle & latter part baffling air and calm. At 7 am took a light westerly breeze by. Lat 20.14 N Long 64.41 W

Monday May 29th

Begins with light westerly breeze and fine weather by. At 2 pm luffed to N. Middle part by N. by E. Latter part fresh breeze with squally humped light air. At 8 am saw the Island of Rodrigues bearing about N. by E. dist. 8 leagues or thereabout, fresh trade steering N.
