Tuesday June 20th

Begins with fresh northwesterly breeze and clear weather steering N.W. at 11 AM moderate breeze made all sail, kept at 7 AM wind veered to N.E. by 1 PM light breeze. At 2 PM took a heavy squall from N.E. headed light sails and doubled reefed the foresail, by 3 PM fresh breeze at 11 PM headed N.E. & Chanker. Latter part continues the same.

Wednesday June 21st

Weather looks threatening about 11 AM had a heavy squall from N.W. took in the courses and doubled reefed the foresail and set to N.E. A light gale. Middle part wind moderated some set doubled foresail. Latter part wind moderated to a fresh breeze set courses fore & Chanker. True to N.W. by 11 PM.

Thursday June 22nd

Begins with fresh southerly breeze and pleasant weather by 11 AM by 1 PM turned the reef out the foresail. Middle part moderate breeze made some light sails. at 4 PM light breeze made all sail. at daylight two sail in sight steering westward. Latter part wind veered to N.W. by 11 PM.

Friday June 23rd

Begins with light southerly breeze and splendid weather steering N.W. at 1 PM wind veered to N.E. by 1 PM and commenced rain, by 3 PM one of our neighbors in off shot ahead the other out of sight astern. Middle part wind continued to increase, at 10 PM took in studding sail and N.E. sail, a light gale. At 11 PM squall took in Main & J. sail and doubled reefed the foresail. Latter part about the same at 11 AM wind moderated to a strong breeze turned the reef out the foresail and set N.E. sail. Wind at 11 PM. Lat. 38. 44 N.
Long. 84. 10 W.

Saturday June 24th

Begins with light northwesterly breeze and pleasant weather steering N.W. by 1 PM wind veered to N.E. by 1 PM with thick haze, some rain and some light rain but the ship under double reef. Middle part squall with light rain. Latter part light southerly breeze with heavy sea heading from N.E. by 11 PM. A sail in sight working westward.

Sunday June 25th

Begins with light westerly air and calm heading southeasterly at 1 PM wind veered to N.E. light breeze started at 1 PM by 1 PM at 1 PM thick threatening weather about 8 PM had a great deal of thunder and lightning but ship under double reef. Middle part wind from all quarters with light rain squalls at 2 PM took a light breeze from N.E. by 1 PM by 1 PM. Latter part moderate southerly breeze steering pastward steering N.W. by 11 PM at 11 PM moderate breeze at 11 PM with thunder in N.E. by 11 PM light rain.
