

Monday Oct 4th
 Begins with light easterly breeze and pleasant weather. Steaming N. about 11 AM good overall condition. Weathered about 11 AM. Middle part continues about the same. Later part light southerly breeze. About 11 AM raised off whales going toward ship. After lowered their boats and gave chase. Ends

Oct 4th 1891
 Temp. 42.4 F.

Tuesday Oct 5th
 Weather still continues about the same. Put in packet. About 12.30 PM first best section. About 2 PM all boats on board and whale made fast. Set road at 3 PM. Finished cutting about 6 PM. Middle part calm with much rain. Employed steering decks. About 2 AM a steamer passed steaming westward. Started to make about same time. Later part light huffing and wind force heading westward. Made off about 10 PM. I got cutting at 10 PM. Finished about 12 PM.

Oct 5th 1891
 Temp. 42.5 F.

Wednesday Oct 6th
 Begins with light northerly breeze and pleasant weather. Steaming N. About 2 PM wind veered to north-west. About 6 PM sighted an English steamer steering eastward. Windward sail at stake. Middle part squally with rain. Double reefed main top sail. Steamed N. V. light breeze. Dined. Later part wind veered south and light rain. H. V. Pan. Pump bores. V. 12 PM set heli. Ends

Oct 6th 1891
 Temp. 50.22 F.

Wind rose late 3 PM
 Temp. 42.1 F.

Wednesday Oct 7th
 About 12 PM wind increased suddenly to light gale. Double reefed top sail. Packet set at stake. Employed steering at between decks. Finished steering about 4 PM. Middle part calm with much rain. About 6 PM set main sail. Set and reefed. Steamer and sailing vessel in sight. About 11 PM wind veered north-west. Packed westward. Later part wind moderating, making sail gradually. Three still passed on eastern tack. Employed at steering about 30 PM at in fore hole between decks. Ends

Oct 7th 1891
 Temp. 57.19 F.

Thursday Oct 8th
 Begins with light northerly breeze and pleasant weather. Steaming N. About 11 AM wind veered to north-west. Middle part wind veered southward. Later part employed steering over all in fore hole between decks. Ends

Oct 8th 1891
 Temp. 52.02 F.

Friday Oct 9th
 Begins with light huffing northerly breeze and pleasant weather. Steaming N. About 11 AM three sail in sight on eastern tack. At 11 PM looked westward. Middle part wind veered westward. About 4 PM steamed N. V. 12 PM set light two sail in sight. One on western tack and the other steering northward. Later part moderate sea with breeze and changing weather with some rain. About 11 PM hoisted fore top, set main sail. About 12 PM fueled light sails except main top, set sail. Ends

Oct 9th 1891
 Temp. 52.4 F.

Wind rose late 3 PM
 Temp. 42.1 F.
