Sept 18

All of these 24 hours fine clear weather wind from S.E. steering on the wind all employed in ship duty at 3 P.M. finished the Gaff topsail and sent it aloft so ends these 24 hours

Saturday
Sept 19

All of these 24 light air and calms wind from E.S.E. all employed in sending down after yards and sending Gaff topsail so ends these 24 hours

Sunday
Sept 20

All of these 24 hours light air from S.S.W. to south steered S.E. by E set studding sail saw jumpters on the lee bow saw two sail on the weather bow

Monday
Sept 21

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes and cloudy from south double reefed the topsails all employed in ship duty the latter part moderate and cloudy bent a new main topsail turned the reef of the fore topsail and main top gallunt sail

Tuesday
Sept 22

All of these 24 hours fine clear weather with the wind S.E. steered E.S.E. and E by S saw Grampuses all employed in ship duty at 8 Am got the new main sail on deck took out 2 cloths and bent it so ends these 24 hours

Sept 23

All of these 24 hours light air and calm clear weather steered S.E. all employed in ship duty saw one sail steering to southward

All of these 24 hours fair weather with moderate breezes from S.E. to E.S.E. ship lays up N.E. by E all employed in turning up and setting rigging at 10 AM saw black fish blowed and chased them come on board and got dinner so ends

Friday
Sept 25

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from S.E. the middle and ^{latter} more moderate with the wind S.W. steered S.E. all employed in turning up rigging saw six sail at 5 pm broke the Brig Forester of New Bedford Capt Keen 11 months out with 200 barrels of Mem Oil so ends

Saturday
Sept 26

All of these 24 hours moderate fine weather wind from S.W. steered S.E. by S at 10 AM saw a Brig steering to the N.E. at 4 pm the wind hauled to the south the first part all employed in the rigging the latter part employed in bracing out fresh water so ends

Sunday
Sept 27

The first part of these 24 hours light breezes from the S.S.W. with fine clear weather saw two sail the latter part light air from S.W. steered S.S.E. set the fore and main Royals so ends

Sept 28

All of these 24 light air from S.S.W. to west steered south saw 2 sail at daylight saw blackfish at 8 Am towed and got 2 fish at 12 o'clock took them in deck and cut them up at sundown calm weather

Tuesday
Sept 29

All of these 24 hours light air and calm all employed in ship duty the first part the latter part employed in building out the black fish there is 4 barrels of it at sundown the weather continues calm hauled up the courses so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday
Sept 30

All of these 24 hours light breezes from S.W. to N.S.W. steered south with moderate clear weather all employed in ship duty at 1 P.M. got up a new main top gallunt studding sail half done finished it at 4 pm set it and one fore D. saw blackfish

Porpoises and 4 sail so ends at sundown tried the pump found the ship tight
