Thursday Nov 12 All of the 24 hours strong breeze from the S.W. with a large swell from the South with fair weather saw a number of Birds at 1 Pm finished the main yard sent it up set the topsail bent the main sail set it, got out a new main topsail and fitted it to the yard at sundown took in and Pump ship
Obs Lat 33.04 N

Friday Nov 13 The first part of the 24 hours strong breeze the S.E. at daylight sent down the Slings of the fore yard found them Broake in three Places and went down after coal for the blacksmith. the middle and latter part strong Gales from S.W. at sundown shortened sail
Obs Lat 34.39 S

Saturday Nov 14 All of these 24 hours fair weather with light breeze from the S.W. and S.W. all employed ship duty saw Porpoises a turtle and a number of Birds at sundown the wind hauled to the N.W. Steered S by W so ends
Obs Lat 34.30 S

Sunday Nov 15 All of these 24 hours fine clear weather with the wind from N to N.W. Steered S by W and S.W. by S. saw finbacks blackfish Porpoises Kelp and a grate quantity of Whale feed so ends
Obs Lat 35.15 S

Monday Nov 16 All of these 24 hours strong breeze from the N.W. steered S.S.W. at 8 am saw finbacks and Porpoises and took top gallant sail in the latter part the breeze increases double Reefed the top sail saw Kelp so ends

Tuesday Nov 17 The first and middle part of these 24 hours strong Gales and Rainy weather all horns below the latter part moderate clear weather with a light breeze from the N.W. saw Whales supposed them to be Right Whale at 5 am set the fore top sail

Wednesday Nov 18 The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the N.W. with lightning took in the fore topsail and fore sail saw finback the latter part strong Gales from the S.W. at 5 pm wore ship and set the fore sail at sundown the weather moderates
Obs Lat 39.32 S

Thursday Nov 19 The first part of these 24 hours light air from the South and cloudy all employed in braking out fresh water at 4 am saw Right wherd and chased them they were bound to the South and East at 2 Pm saw Right whale again bound quick to windward bowend and chased them but got none came on board and stowed off the hole the latter part light breeze from the N.W. Steered South so ends
Obs Lat 39.19 South

Friday Nov 20 All of these 24 hours strong breeze from the North with thick chazy weather Steered South all employed in ship duty at 5 pm saw a Basque Bound to Northward at sundown took stueling sails and Pump ship
Obs Lat 41.49 S

Saturday Nov 21 The first part of these 24 hours thick foggy weather ~~weather~~ with the wind from the North Steered South 1/2 E. saw finback and blackfish the middle and latter part clear the wind from the S.W. and W.S.W. Steered S.S.E. at 7 pm took in fore topsail main sail and jib so ends
Obs Lat 44.01 S

Sunday Nov 22 The first part of these 24 hours strong Gales from the North took in the fore sail and close Reefed the main topsail saw Worgans and Kelp the latter part strong Gales from the W.S.W. set the fore sail and fore top mast stay sail and wore ship
Obs Lat 45.27 S

Monday Nov 23 The first part of these 24 hours strong Gales from the S.W. set the fore sail and fore top sail at 1 pm moved the Cook house aft saw nothing the latter part moderate weather made sail the wind from the W.S.W. so ends
Obs Lat 46.48 South
