- Friday Feb th 12 All of these 24 hours light basterlin winds at daylight saw Charleses Island bearing E. all employed in bending Chanes and getting the anchors of the Bow but the winds were so light we could not anchor at sundown the bearing S.E. dist 15 leagues of
- Saturday Feb th 13 The first part of these 24 hours light airs and calms saw finbacks and Porpoises the India in sight at 4 Pm lowered 4 Boats and towed in shore light breezes from the S.E. at 8 Pm let go our anchor in 18 fathoms of water 24 mile from shore. took the Boat up and furlled the sails
- Charleses Island
- Sunday Feb th 14 The first part of these 24 hours light airs and calms of shore with rain at 9 am took our anchor and towed up the Bay. let the anchor go in 9 1/2 fath of water and sent all hands ashore the latter part fine clear weather.
- Monday Feb th 15 All of these 24 hours fine weather at daylight sent one Boat after Turpin the Remainer employed in Painting Ship.
- Tuesday Feb th 16 All of these 24 hours light winds and Rainy weather at 8 am sent 3 Boats to Black Beach for Potatoes and Turpin got 13 bbs of Potatoes and 9 Turpin
To do this 24 hours with Rain

- Thursday Feb th 18 All of these 24 light and calms at daylight got out Vanhook and went to sea from Charles Island at 8 Stowed the anchors on the bow and the Chanes below at 1 Pm saw bone shank lowered and struck him and lost a Boat and craft came on board and steered W.S.W. saw a Ship
- Wednesday Feb th 17 All of these 24 hours fine clear weather sent 3 Boats for Potatoes got 17 bbs and 20 bunches of Bananachs and 30 Pumpkins. and William Colman Run away.
- Friday Feb th 19 All of these 24 hours light trades and clear Steered N.W. and S.W. all employed in Ship duty saw blackfish and Porpoises at sundown took in sail Lat 1.43 S

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- Saturday Feb th 20 All of these 24 hours fine clear weather light trades Steered S.W. saw Porpoises and finbacks at 3 am cast a Shank at sundown took in sail
Obs Lat 1.45 S
- Sunday Feb th 21 The first part of these 24 hours light trades and clear weather W.S.W. at daylight saw a Ship the latter part cloudy with Showers of Rain saw finbacks and Porpoises at sundown took in sail

- Monday Feb th 22 All of these 24 hours light trades and cloudy with Showers of Rain Steered N.W. saw finback and Porpoises at 6 Pm Shode the India of New Bedford at sundown took in sail

- Tuesday Feb th 23 All of these 24 hour light breezes from the S.E. with thick Rainy weather Steered W by N saw finbacks and Porpoises at sundown took in sail
