Thursday  
May 13 The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the N.W. steered N.E. & all employed in ship duty saw finbacks and jumpers the latter part strong gales and thick weather from S.W. steered East at sundown took in sail

Friday  
May 14 All of these 24 hours moderate breezes from the W.S.W. steered S.E. at 1 pm tacked ship and steered North all employed in ship duty saw a number of finbacks at sundown took in sail

May 15 The first part of these 24 hours strong gales from the S.W. with fog steered North. The latter part moderate breezes from the West with thick fog and rain all employed in ship duty saw nothing

Tuesday  
May 18 All of these 24 hours light airs and calms all employed in ship duty saw killers and Grampusses at sundown took in sail  
Obs Lat 44.12 N

Wednesday  
May 19 All of these 24 hours moderate breezes from the E.N.E. with cloudy weather all employed in ship duty saw finbacks Porpoises and a old log of wood and several sticks and weeds at sundown took in sail  
Obs Lat 44.14 N

Thursday  
May 20 All of these 24 hours moderate breezes from the N.N.W. steered N.E. with fine clear weather all employed in ship duty saw jumpers at sundown took in sail  
Obs Lat 45.05 N

Friday  
May 21 All of these 24 hours moderate breezes from S.W. to W. with cloudy rainy weather steered N by E all employed in ship duty saw finbacks and Porpoises at sundown took in sail  
Obs Lat 46.07 N

Saturday  
May 22 The first part of these 24 hours calms all employed in ship duty saw finbacks and Grampusses the latter part light breezes from N.N.W. at sundown took in sail so ends
