Tuesday August 3 All of these 24 hours strong gales from the S.E. with the Rain at 8 Am took in the fore sail and layed the Ship two at Sundown Pump Ship. Nothing to be seen this day

Wednesday August 4 All of these 24 hours moderate breezes from the S.E. with Showers of Rain steering to the Southward saw Porpoises at Sundown Pump Ship

Thursday August 5 All of these 24 hours moderate breezes from the S.W. with fine weather Steered S.E. at 2 Pm unbent the fore top sail and bent another Nothing to be seen this day
