Sept 29 Fresh trades all of these 24 hours with
Showers of Rain employed in corking Ship
and Painting mast

Wednesday
Sept 30 Fresh trades all of these 24 hours and clear
employed in corking Ship and Painting one
half of the crew on Shore at 3 Pm the Ship
sailed arrived with 1000 lbs of Whale oil

Thursday
Sept 1 All of these 24 hours fine clear weather
one half of the crew on Shore the others
employed in Stowing Water

Friday
Sept 2 Fine weather all of these 24 hours corking
Ship in employed in sending Brane on
Shore and Painting Ship

Saturday
Sept 3 Fine weather all of these 24 hours Corkers
employed in Corking the Ship and the Ship's
crew employed in Stowing Water

Sunday
Sept 4 Fine clear weather all hands on Shore
at midnight a man by the name of
Davis was taken violently ill had to
send for a Doctor at daylight no better

Monday
Sept 5 All of these 24 hours fine weather one
half of the crew on and others employed
in Scraping and Painting Ship

Tuesday
Sept 6 The greater part of these 24 hours Showery
employed in Painting Ship

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Wednesday
Sept 6 Fine clear weather all of these 24 hours
employed Painting Ship in side at 10pm
discharged James Davis and Paid him
of \$75.75 and he went to the counsel

Thursday
Sept 7 Fine clear weather all of these 24 hours
at 8 Am one half of the crew went on Shore
the others employed in cooping meet and
Stowing it in the Run

Friday
Sept 8 All of these 24 hours fine clear weather at
8 Am one half of the crew went on Shore
the others employed in getting the Ship
Ready for Sea at 8 Am the Ship sailed
Arrived with 3500 lbs of oil

Saturday
Sept 9 All of these 24 hours moderate trades and
clear at 10 Am the Pilot came on board
and took our anchor, bound for Nowee
at 11 Am 10 discharged the Pilot and steered
up for that Place so ends

Sunday
Sept 10 All of these 24 hours light air and calm
the latter part Showers of Rain employed
in fetching in betwixt Ransel and
Lawson for Nowee so ends

Monday
Sept 11 All of these 24 hours fine clear weather
at 9 Am came to anchor at Nowee in
80 fathoms of water sent half of the crew
on Shore the others employed in getting of
Recruits

Tuesday
Sept 12 All of these 24 hours fine clear weather
at 8 Am the Elbe sailed employed in
getting off Recruits

Wednesday
Sept 13 All of these 24 hours fine weather all
employed in getting off Recruits at 6 Pm
took our anchor and went to sea on a
course at 9 Amni bore SSW Nowee
bearing N. E. dist 4 miles
