Thursday Sept 14 All of these 24 hours fine clear weather wind N.E. Steering on the wind to Southward Saw nothing all employed in stowing away ground tack in and getting the boats ready for Whaling

Lat 20. 34 N

Friday Sept 15 All of these 24 hours light airs and calm Steered S.E. by E. all employed in ship duty at 9 Pm saw Whales lowerd ship's Q and saved one at 9 took him along side

Lat 19. 15 N

Saturday Sept 16 All of these 24 hours fresh trades N.E. at daylight commenced cutting and at 8 am finished employed in ship duty saw nothing this day

Lat 18. 05 N

Sunday Sept 17 All of these 24 hours strong breezes from the E.N.E. Steered S.E. at 3 am commenced boiling on the whale at 3 Pm finished nothing in sight to day

Lat 17. 30 N

Monday Sept 18 All of these 24 hours strong breezes from E.N.E. Steered S.E. at 8 am saw Whales lowerd Chusee did not strike all employed in ship duty

Lat 16. 03 N

Tuesday Sept 19 The first part squally wind N.E. Steered E.S.E. Singal Reeped the topsail at daylight made all sail moderate all employed in ship duty the middle part clear the latter part squally Reeped the topsail again nothing to be seen this day

Lat 14. 10 N

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Wednesday Sept 20 All of these 24 hours strong breezes from E.N.E. Steered S.E. under singal Reeped topsails all employed mending sail Nothing seen to day

Lat 13. 33 N

Thursday Sept 21 All of these 24 hours strong breezes from N.E. with squalls of Rain all employed in mending sail Nothing seen to day Steered E.S.E. the end

Lat 12. 20 N

Friday Sept 22 The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from N.E. and cloudy all employed in mending sail at 2 pm sent up foretopgallant sail at 3 bent new main top sail the latter part strong gales with Rain squalls

Lat 10. 54 N

Saturday Sept 23 All of these 24 hours Rainy squally weather from N.E. Steered E.S.E. employed in getting up Rigging and other ship duty Nothing seen to day at 6 double Reeped the topsails

Lat 9. 54 N

Sunday Sept 24 The first of these 24 hours strong gales and squally weather at 4 am parted the foretopgallant stay at 8 took in main sail and foretop sail the latter part moderate weather made sail and Steered S.E. Nothing seen to day
