Monday Sept 27 The first of these 24 hours light air and calms, all employed in setting up Rigging the latter part strong breezes with rain. Steered S.E. & Nothing seen to day  
Lat 08-00 N

Tuesday Sept 28 All of these 24 hours light winds and squally weather all employed in setting up Rigging at 10 Am saw sperm Whales lowered Land struck one with 2 Boats took him alongside and cutt him in at 6 Pm finished mack sail and steered to Southward  
Lat 08-00 N

Wednesday Sept 29 The first part light moderate weather and cloudy the wind S.E. all employed in boiling the latter part Raining squally weather at 8 Pm finished boiling  
Saw Porpoises  
Lat 7-08 N

Thursday Sept 30 All of these 24 hours strong Gales from the S.E. with squalls of Rain Steered to Southward all employed in ship duty saw Nothing to day  
Lat 6-15 N

Friday Oct 1 All of these 24 hours strong breezes from S.E. and cloudy Steered S.W. all employed in ship duty Nothing seen to day

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Saturday Oct 2 All of these 24 hours fine clear weather light breezes from S.E. Steered S.W. all employed in ship duty saw Grampuses  
Lat 4-41 N

Sunday Oct 3 All of these 24 hours strong Gales from the S.E. Steered S.W. at 8 Pm saw Whales lowered and chased them at sundown came on board and took in sail and to N.E.  
Lat 3-13 N

Monday Oct 4 All of these 24 hours strong breezes from the East Steered S.E. all employed in mending and bending sail at sundown put one Reef in the foretop sail Nothing seen to day  
Lat 1-40 N

Tuesday Oct 5 All of these 24 hours fine moderate weather wind from the E. Steered S.E. all employed in mending sail and Boats saw finbacks and Porpoises  
Lat 00-03 South

Wednesday Oct 6 All of these 24 hours light air and calms Steered S.E. by S all employed in mending sail and other duty Nothing seen to day  
Saw Porpoises  
Lat 1-32 South

Thursday Oct 7 All of these 24 hours light air and calms Steered S.E. by S all employed in ship duty saw Porpoises  
Lat 2-22 S
